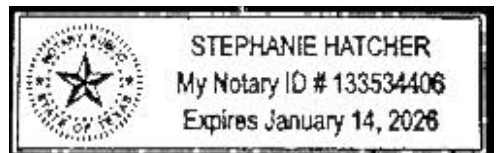

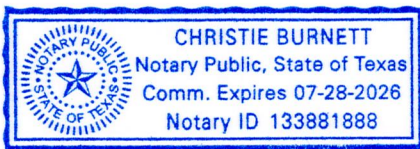

UPDATED PROPERTY TAX INFORMATION NOW AVAILABLE FOR TEXAS TAXPAYERS

Pittsburg-New and updated property tax information has just been compiled by Camp Central Appraisal District and is available now to assist taxpayers. This property tax information is current and covers a wide range of topics, such as taxpayer remedies, exemptions, appraisals, and has information for select groups, such as disabled veterans and persons who are 65 years of age or older.

"Whether you are a homeowner, business owner, disabled veteran or a taxpayer, it's important you know your rights concerning the property tax laws" said Jan Tinsley, Chief Appraiser of the Camp Central Appraisal District. You can contact us about any property tax issues with full confidence that we will provide the most complete, accurate and up-to-date information available to assist you.

This includes information about the following programs.

Property Tax Exemption for Disabled Veterans – The law provides partial exemptions for any property owned by disabled veterans or surviving spouses and surviving children of deceased disabled veterans. Another partial exemption is for homesteads donated to disabled veterans by charitable organizations at no cost or not more than 50 percent of the good faith estimate of the homestead's market value to the disabled veterans and their surviving spouses. The exemption amount is determined according to percentage of service-connected disability. The law also provides a 100 percent exemption for 100 percent disabled veterans and their surviving spouses and for surviving spouses of U.S. armed service members killed or fatally injured in the line of duty.

Property Tax Exemptions – Non-profit organizations that meet statutory requirements may seek property tax exemptions and must apply to their county appraisal district by a specific date. Businesses that receive tax abatements granted by taxing units; ship inventory out of Texas that may be eligible for the freeport exemption; store certain goods in transit in warehouses that are moved within 175 days; construct, install or acquire pollution control property; own and operate energy storage systems; convert landfill-generated gas; or store offshore drilling equipment while not in use may also be eligible for statutory exemptions.

Rendering Taxable Property – If a business owns tangible personal property that is used to produce income, the business must file a rendition with its local county appraisal district by a specified date. Personal property includes inventory and equipment used by a business. Owners do not have to render exempt property such as church property or an agriculture producer's equipment used for farming.

Appraisal Notices – Normally, taxpayers receive a notice of appraised value from the appropriate local appraisal district. The city, county, school districts and other local taxing units use the appraisal district's value to set property taxes for the coming year.

Property Tax Remedies – This Comptroller publication explains in detail how to protest a property appraisal, what issues the county appraisal review board (ARB) can consider and what to expect during a protest hearing. The publication also discusses the option to request limited binding arbitration to compel the ARB or chief appraiser to comply with a procedural requirement and the options of taking a taxpayer's case to district court, the State Office of Administrative Hearings or binding arbitration if the taxpayer is dissatisfied with the outcome of the ARB hearing.

Homestead Exemptions – A homestead is generally defined as the home and land used as the owner's principal residence on Jan. 1 of the tax year. A person who acquires property after Jan. 1 may receive the residence homestead exemption for the applicable portion of that tax year immediately on qualification for the exemption if the preceding owner did not receive the same exemption for that tax year. A homestead exemption reduces the home's appraised value and, as a result, lowers property taxes. Applications are submitted to the appropriate local appraisal district.

Productivity Appraisal – Property owners who use land for timber land production, agricultural purposes or wildlife management can be granted property tax relief on their land. They may apply to their local appraisal district for an agricultural special appraisal which may result in a lower appraisal of the land based on production, versus market value.

Residence Homestead Tax Deferral – Texas homeowners may postpone paying the currently delinquent property taxes due on the appreciating value of their homes by filing a tax deferral affidavit at their local appraisal district. This tax relief allows homeowners to pay the property taxes on 105 percent of the preceding year's appraised value of their homestead, plus the taxes on any new improvements to the homestead. The deferral postpones the remaining taxes, with interest accruing at 8 percent per year but does not cancel them.

Property Tax Deferral for Persons Age 65 or Older or Disabled or Disabled Veteran Homeowners – Texans who are age 65 or older or disabled, as defined by law, or who qualify for a disabled veteran exemption may postpone paying current and delinquent property taxes on their homes by signing a tax deferral affidavit. Once the affidavit is on file, taxes are deferred, but not cancelled, as long as the owner continues to own and live in the home. Interest continues to accrue at 5 percent per year on the unpaid taxes. You may obtain a deferral affidavit at the appraisal district.

Notice of Availability of Electronic Communication – In appraisal districts located in counties with a population of more than 200,000 or that have authorized electronic communications, and that have implemented a system that allows such communications, chief appraisers and ARBs may communicate electronically through email or other media with property owners or their designated representatives. Written agreements are required for notices and other documents to be delivered electronically instead of mailing.

Protesting Property Appraisal Values – Property owners who disagree with the appraisal district's appraisal of their property for local taxes or for any other action that adversely affects them may protest their property value to the appraisal district's ARB.

Informal Meetings-Property owners can request an informal meeting with appraisal district staff to try and resolve their disputes prior to attending ARB hearings.

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

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Hamlin starts CPR awareness campaign

Buffalo Bills safety Damar Hamlin is using his harrowing experience to raise awareness and money for CPR. In the process he's challenging three cultural titans to do the same.

Hamlin announced Wednesday he is partnering with the American Heart Association to launch the "#3forHeart CPR Challenge," a social media campaign intended to raise CPR education and training by challenging people on social platforms to participate. To initiate the campaign, Hamlin challenged NFL quarterback Tom Brady, who announced his retirement earlier on Wednesday, former first lady Michelle Obama and Los Angeles Lakers star LeBron James in a message posted on his verified Twitter account.

"I'm excited to be teaming up with the American Heart Association," Hamlin said Wednesday in a news release. "It's

going to be an amazing opportunity to impact and educate millions of people

on the importance of CPR. It literally saved my life."

The challenge involves three steps. The first is to visit the website of the challenge, heart.org/3, to watch a minute-long video on how to perform hands-only CPR. The second is to donate to the American Heart Association and the third is to use the hashtag #3forHeart to challenge three people on social media to do the same.

Hamlin, 24, suffered cardiac arrest during a "Monday Night Football" game Jan. 2 against the Cincinnati Bengals after he collided with Bengals receiver Tee Higgins. The play happened during the first quarter of the game, which was temporarily suspended then subsequently postponed. Hamlin was treated with CPR and an automated external defibrillator, and his heartbeat was restored on the field before he was transferred to the University of Cincinnati Medical Center. The game was later canceled.

After Hamlin completed what doctors have called a "remarkable recovery," he was released from the hospital nine days after the incident. Hamlin visited the team facility while the Bills were in the playoffs and attended Buffalo's divisional round loss against the Bengals just three weeks after his incident.

"The world watched in fear when Damar collapsed during that game," Nancy Brown, CEO of the American Heart Association, said in a news release. "But if you follow his advice, you can become a lifesaver in 3 steps, and you'll know what to do in the event an adult or teen suddenly collapses in your presence. Because most cardiac arrests that happen outside of a hospital occur in the home, the life you save will most likely be a loved one. The volunteers, supporters and staff of the American Heart Association are so grateful that he is paying it forward and helping ensure others also have a better chance for a positive outcome."

Kaepernick proved right again and again

In February for Black History Month, USA TODAY Sports is publishing the series "28 Black Stories in 28 Days." We examine the issues, challenges and opportunities Black athletes and sports officials continue to face after the nation's reckoning on race following the murder of George Floyd in 2020. This is the third annual installment of the series.

One of the first comments Colin Kaepernick made after his initial series of protests in 2016 was to Steve Wyche from the NFL Network.

"I am not going to stand up to show pride in a flag for a country that oppresses black people and people of color," Kaepernick said. "To me, this is bigger than football and it would be selfish on my part to look the other way. There are bodies in the street and people getting paid leave and getting away with murder."

That comment, and his continued protests, launched a thousand hateful ships, as the right wing, and even a president, spent years attacking him.

In the end, however, what we knew then, and especially know now, is that Kaepernick wasn't just right, he was prescient. What happened in the years that followed were numerous incidents of police brutality against

Black and brown men.

Kaepernick has long been a hero, but he's in a totally different place than he was in 2016. He's become one of the most vital civil rights figures of our time. If you think that's an exaggeration, you

haven't been paying attention.

Kaepernick predicted all of this

Four years after Kaepernick started his protests, George Floyd was mur-

dered by Derek Chauvin.

Most recently, of course, came the horrific beating of Tyre Nichols, which led to Nichols' death and five police officers being charged with murder.

Those are just two of the names. There were so many others.

Kaepernick knew that because of systemic racism, there would be more horrible incidents between Black citizens and the police. He was, of course, right.

That fact has been at the core of Kaepernick's message throughout the years: injustice toward one group of Americans hurts us all.

"How can you stand for the national anthem of a nation that preaches and propagates, 'freedom and justice for all,'" he once said, "that is so unjust to so many of the people living there?"

Another Kaepernick project

Kaepernick is the executive producer for a new documentary on Hulu called "Killing County," which is set to debut Friday. It's set in Bakersfield, California, which is the home district of House Speaker Kevin McCarthy.

The documentary examines what the filmmakers say is an inordinate amount of police violence in Bakersfield.

With the documentary, Kaepernick is doing what he's done for years, which is shine a light wherever it needs to go. He did that in 2016 by protesting. He was right.

And he's been right again and again and again.

Eagles super fan Trout sees memes about Angels

Mike Trout's favorite offseason pastime also creates a certain kind of personal hell.

Trout, the Los Angeles Angels All-Star and three-time American League Most Valuable Player, is among the most notable celebrity fans of the Philadelphia Eagles, long his favorite team since growing up across the Delaware River in Millville, New Jersey.

He was on hand for the team's 31-7 throttling of the San Francisco 49ers in Sunday's NFC championship game, sending the Eagles to their second Super Bowl in six seasons.

Yet the juxtaposition with his own

team's postseason failures is often too much to ignore.

"It crushes me," Trout, whose Angels have appeared only once in the playoffs, a three-game sweep at the hands of the Kansas City Royals in the 2014 AL division series, said on an ESPN podcast. "I want to experience the playoff atmosphere. I got to experience a little taste of it in '14."

"But it's been a while. I can't imagine what the players are going through and I think that everybody that competes in sports wants that feeling."

More than a few social media snarkers have noted that Trout has attended more Eagles playoff games than he has participated in with the Angels. He sees you, he hears you, he scrolls with you.

"I see all the GIFs, all the memes," he says. "I get a kick out of it."

He can try to change it soon; Trout will report to spring training in about two weeks, represent Team USA in the World Baseball Classic and then try to push the playoff boulder up the hill in Anaheim.

With eight seasons remaining on his \$427.5 million contract, there's precious little choice, even if his hometown Phillies reached the World Series.

"It gets brought up to me a lot," says Trout of somehow playing in Philly someday. "I hear it a lot from Eagles fans when I go to the games ... there's a group of people that's always trying to push me to go to the Phillies."

"It's always going to be linked to me."

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Italian edges Shiffrin in world super-G

MERIBEL, France — Two days after Federica Brignone won the gold medal in the combined to open the skiing world championships, Italian teammate Marta Bassino added another in the super-G by edging Mikaela Shiffrin.

And Sofia Goggia will be a favorite for yet another Italian victory in Saturday's downhill, with Elena Curtoni a strong contender, too.

Italy sure is looking good so far, even before Bassino tries to defend her title in the parallel race and she and Brignone go for gold in the giant slalom.

"Federica had a great performance. It was something that inspired me a lot, because a lot of times she inspires me. The attitude to attack the slope and push every turn," Bassino said. "I was thinking, 'We are teammates, we work together, I can do the same thing.'"

Shiffrin had to settle for silver in the super-G on Wednesday, two days after she didn't finish the second leg of the combined.

Goggia finished 11th. "Great, now the pressure is on me," Goggia said. "First Fede, then Marta and, and let's see."

Bassino earned her second gold medal at the world championships after sharing victory with Austrian skier Katharina Liensberger in the parallel event at her home worlds two years ago.

She became the second Italian skier to win the women's super-G world title. Isolde Kostner won back-to-back golds in the mid-1990s, while Deborah Compagnoni won the Olympic super-G title in Meribel at the 1992 Albertville Games.

Bassino has yet to win a super-G on the World Cup circuit but did finish third in two races in January.

"I'm speechless. It's my first win in super-G, and here at the world championships. It is something I have to realize," Bassino said. "Today I just did a great last part because I lost a lot of time in the first part. I was really suffering

watching all the other girls coming down. I'm really happy and confident in myself. It's really a great result for me."

In the super-G portion of the combined, Bassino showed that she was at ease on the bumps of the Roc de Fer course. She went out of the race because of a mistake, but before that she had been among the fastest.

"I had everything right in my head," Bassino said. "I'm really happy. The gold in parallel two years ago was nice, but today it's something extra, something bigger. I'm really happy with myself and at the same time amazed that I did the race so well."

Shiffrin said she expected Bassino to do well after seeing her shortly before

the race. "I could see her in the start, she looked in the right zone," Shiffrin said. "I could see she has the flow and I (was) like, 'Now I have to focus on myself and stop looking at Marta.'"

Shiffrin, who won super-G gold in 2019 and bronze two years ago, led Bassino by three-tenths of a second at the second split but couldn't match the Italian's pace in the last part of the course and finished second, 0.11 seconds behind.

Comelia Huetter of Austria and Kaja Vickhoff Lie of Norway tied for third, 0.33 seconds behind, to share the bronze medal.

"I'm so happy with my run, and emotional, because I don't really feel like I

should be winning a medal in super-G right now. There are so many women so strong and so fast," Shiffrin said.

"There was one moment where I thought I lost everything but then I could keep it rolling until the finish."

The silver is Shiffrin's 12th medal in 15 career world championship races, giving her outright second place on the all-time list for the most medals won by a woman at the worlds, trailing only German skier Christl Cranz, who won 15 in the 1930s.

Shiffrin had been heading for a possible medal in the combined event on Monday before straddling the third-to-last gate in the slalom portion.

"I felt like I learned from the combined that I have to be much more aggressive with my skiing and with my tactics," said Shiffrin, who was sixth in Monday's super-G run.

"Also, this hill is difficult and it deserves respect for the terrain. You have to push the limit but if you go over the limit, it's even worse. So I was trying to be really strong, really aggressive and just also a little bit smart."

Shiffrin has 11 wins on the World Cup circuit this season to take her overall tally to 85 — breaking Lindsey Vonn's women's record of 82 and moving within one of the overall mark set by Ingemar Stenmark in the 1970s and '80s.

Many pre-race favorites, including defending and Olympic champion Lara Gut-Behrami and Swiss teammate Corinne Suter, led Bassino by several tenths of a second before losing substantial time in the technically demanding middle section of the course, which was partly shadowed.

American racer Tricia Mangan skied through a gate and crashed, breaking her right ski, but she appeared to escape serious injury.

Before the race, French air force aerobatics squad Patrouille de France performed a demonstration of formation changes and crossovers with eight jets.

Dawn Staley claps back at Geno Auriemma's criticism

COLUMBIA, S.C. — South Carolina women's basketball coach Dawn Staley called out UConn coach Geno Auriemma on Tuesday for comments the Huskies coach made about the Gamecocks' play style after their 81-77 win in Connecticut on Sunday.

Auriemma received a technical foul in the rivalry game for throwing a water bottle onto the court as he shouted at officials for a decision he disagreed with in the fourth quarter.

After the game, Auriemma repeatedly criticized South Carolina's physical playing style and the lack of calls that the Gamecocks received.

"I just couldn't keep quiet any longer. The technical was stupid, but I didn't say anything for a long, long, long time," Auriemma said. "If you want to bring Lou (Lopez Senechal) in and you can see the bruises on her body. It's just appalling what teams do to her now."

"It's not basketball anymore. I don't know what it is, but it's not basketball."

During the game, 44 fouls were called: 23 against UConn and 21 against South Carolina. It was the most fouls that had been called against the Gamecocks in any game this season.

Staley was heated in her response on her radio call-in show Tuesday and expressed frustration with her team's accomplishments being invalidated.

"Every time that we're successful, we're called something other than players that are locked in," Staley said. "They

play the right way and approach it the right way whether they win or lose. We don't denounce anybody's play. They are always uplifting the game of women's basketball, and when we were getting our heads beat in by UConn for all those years, I said nothing."

The Gamecocks' victory over UConn was the first in program history on the Huskies' home court. South Carolina has now won four of the last five meetings in the series after losing the first eight from 2007 to 2019. The Gamecocks also beat UConn last season in the

NCAA championship game.

Staley was also angered by Auriemma's comments because of their connotation toward a majority-Black team led by a Black head coach. She referenced comments made on a UConn fan page on Facebook earlier this season that called the Gamecocks "thugs," as well as a post on Twitter by an LSU fan two weeks ago that compared them to inmates at a men's prison.

"We've been called so many things and I'm sick of it. I'm sick of it because I coach some of the best human beings

that the game has ever had," Staley said. "We've been called thugs. We've been called prisoners. We've been called monkeys. ..."

"We take this very seriously being the No. 1 team in the country, being a team that young people look at and want to emulate. We set the example of how you do it and do it the right way."

"I am not going to stand down when you're going to denounce how we play, because you're denouncing our national championship. You're denouncing the product that we put up on the floor. You're denouncing families. You're denouncing our achievements, and I'm not going to stand by and allow people just to say that."

The Gamecocks coach addressed the comment that Lopez-Senechal had "bruises," noting that the game was physical on both sides.

South Carolina star Aliyah Boston faced double- and triple-teams nearly every time she held the ball in the paint, as did center Kamilla Cardoso.

"When you say it's not basketball, when you say your player has bruises on her body, our entire post players if we unclothed them, you will see the bruises," Staley said. "We play in the SEC, and that's how we play and we're not going to change it."

The No. 1 Gamecocks (23-0, 12-0 SEC) are back in action at Auburn (13-9, 3-7) on Thursday, and the attention will then turn to another highly anticipated matchup against No. 2 LSU (23-0, 13-0) in front of a sold-out crowd at Colonial Life Arena on Sunday (2 p.m. ET, ESPN).




