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

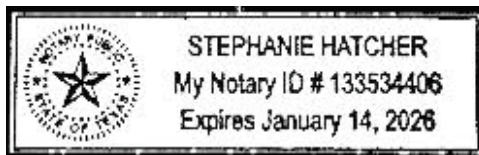

Mahomes reveals his favorite completion to ex-Chiefs WR Hill

Few teams in NFL history have had better picks in consecutive drafts than the Chiefs.

In 2016, the Chiefs selected wide receiver Tyreek Hill in the fifth round. He's since been named an All-Pro four times and is on pace this year to shatter the record for receiving yards in a season.

A year later, the Chiefs traded up and drafted quarterback Patrick Mahomes, who already had won the NFL MVP and Super Bowl MVP awards twice.

During his weekly conversation on KCSF (610 AM), Mahomes was asked how important Hill was early in his career. Mahomes said Hill's work ethic rubbed off on him.

"He's extremely important, man," Mahomes said. "I mean you still see it to this day, the way he's able to win one on one and just make plays happen. Everybody sees the physical, the speed and how he's able to go and make the catches and stuff like that. But I don't think everybody sees how hard that man works. He's one of the hardest working guys I've ever been around."

"And as a young guy to see a guy that's that talented work that hard, it kind of put a stamp on me to go out there and continue to work hard. And so I'm happy for Tyreek, man, he's had a hell of a season so far this year and he had one last year. It'll be a great matchup for us to go up against that football team."

The Chiefs traded Hill to the Miami Dolphins

ahead of the 2022 season, and the teams will meet this Sunday in Frankfurt, Germany. Kansas City received five draft picks* for Hill, and the Chiefs used them to bring in new players, many on defense.

*Fun fact: The Chiefs ended up trading all five of those picks

Mahomes said the trade was a win for both teams.

"I'm happy for him that he got to a place where he's close to his family," Mahomes said. "He got to make a lot of money and he's still going out there and competing every single week and dominating the NFL, man. And so I'm happy for him, and we're having a pretty great season (this year) so far."

"And so it's rare in the NFL for it to work for both sides. But I'm glad it did, because like I said, he's

one of my brothers."

Mahomes said he talks with Hill on occasion, although not as much during the season because both are so busy.

"We still have a good relationship man. He was a brother to me," Mahomes said. "He helped me have a lot of great times in Kansas City, not only on the field but off of it as well and kind of welcomed me into the culture that the Chiefs had before

I even got here. And so I'll always be rooting for him and hopefully he's gonna go out there and put up 2,000 receiving yards, just hopefully not a lot of them are on us."

FAVORITE PLAY

Mahomes was asked for his most memorable pass to Hill, and some might think it was the Jet Chip Wasp in Super Bowl LIV. Or maybe the long touchdown in the 13-second

playoff game against the Bills.

Instead, Mahomes pointed to the fourth-down pass against Baltimore at GEHA Field at Arrowhead Stadium in 2018.

The Chiefs trailed late and faced a fourth down when Mahomes connected with Hill on a 48-yard completion with less than 2 minutes to play. The Chiefs ended up scoring a touchdown to force overtime and won in the extra period.

"Just for him to know the situation — running to the right and just looking and seeing Tyreek and just kind of put it out there to let him try to make a play," Mahomes said. "And him coming back to the ball ... he wasn't even 100% healthy that game."

"It just speaks to the type of competitor that he is, that he would battle through little stuff like that to go out there and be there for his teammates, and I respect that about his game."

KU, K-State, Missouri make first CFP rankings of season

Kansas, K-State and Missouri fans all had to feel happy about the first College Football Playoff

rankings of the season when they were unveiled on Tuesday.

All three teams are ranked in the CFP top 25. The Missouri Tigers checked in at No. 12 after getting off to an

impressive 7-1 start. They can move up even higher next week if they can pull off an upset over No. 2 Georgia.

The Kansas Jayhawks came in nine spots lower at No. 21. This is the first

time KU has ever been ranked in the CFP top 25. It earned a spot in the rankings by starting 6-2 and pulling off a thrilling victory over Oklahoma on Saturday.

The K-State Wildcats

weren't far behind at No. 23. Chris Klieman's team is off to a 6-2 start and will have an opportunity to rise in the rankings with a road game against No. 7 Texas next up on the schedule.

Other Big 12 teams in

the CFP top 25 are No. 9 Oklahoma and No. 22 Oklahoma State.

Ohio State is ranked No. 1 this week, followed by Georgia, Michigan, Florida State and Washington.

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) is seeking public input on a Proposed Plan to address contamination at the Federal Center Complex Former Landfill Area in Kansas City, Missouri. The site is approximately 300 acres and is located at the intersection of Troost Avenue and East Barnharter Road in Kansas City, Missouri. Mizzou's Vanover out in season opener due to NCAA suspension

Mizzou fans will have to wait to see their new big man.

Missouri men's basketball center Connor Vanover, a 7-foot-5 Oral Roberts transfer, will miss the first three games of the season due to "participation in The Portsmouth Invitational Tournament in April," the team announced via its X (Twitter) account Monday evening.

Less than two hours before the Tigers began the season against UAAPB.

Through a spokesperson, Missouri said it was an NCAA decision. MU defeated Arkansas-Tine Bluff 101-79 Monday night at Mizzou Arena.

Vanover, the tallest player in college basketball, transferred to the Tigers in June. During a media session on Oct. 16, he said that during the offseason he was unsure whether he was going

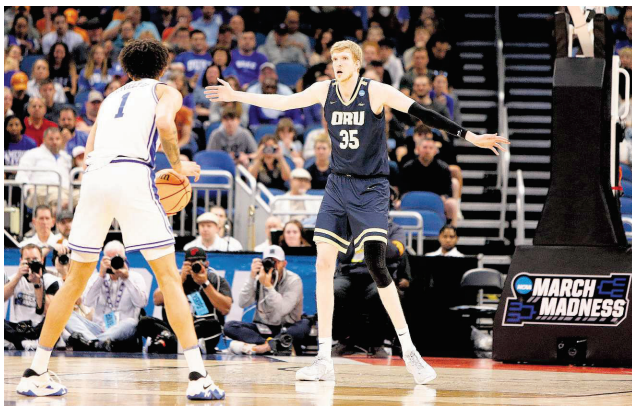
for his final year of eligibility to turn pro or return to college, saying he had declared for the NBA Draft.

The Portsmouth Invitational Tournament is a professional preparatory event, with 64 seniors participating each year in front of scouts. Per the tournament's website, participation may "adversely impact" a player's collegiate eligibility.

The website notes: "Please be advised that, due to NCAA rules governing the NBA pre-Draft process, participating in the Portsmouth Invitational Tournament may adversely impact a player's ability to return to college to compete in NCAA Men's Basketball during the (season) or any subsequent season."

The tournament website suggests players converse with their "head coach and the compliance department at their educational institution" about how participation may impact them.

With the tournament

"Through its use of technology, TGL is a modern twist of traditional golf and ultimately will make the sport I love more accessible," Woods said in a statement. "Having the opportunity to not only compete, but also own a

team to represent Jupiter is an exciting next chapter for me. I expect Jupiter Links GC to showcase the golf culture of my hometown as we compete against the best players in the world."

Blitzler said he is excited about the partnership. "Tiger Woods is one of the most influential and iconic athletes in the history of sports, and I'm thrilled to partner with him to form Jupiter Links GC," Blitzler said. "Golf is a sport that has a proven ability to bring people together from all over the world, and I'm excited by the potential reach and impact we can have as a team and league."

Woods has mostly absent from competitive golf since a February 2021 single-car crash near Los Angeles left him with devastating injuries to his right leg. He has played in some majors, as well as with his teenage son, Charlie, in special events. The 47-year-old Woods has not yet disclosed whether he and Charlie will play in the PNC Championship in Orlando next month.

McIlroy also will play in the new league, which will feature 13 regular-season matches, then playoffs, all contested from a specially designed venue in Palm Beach Gardens, Fla. McIlroy is on the roster of the Boston Common.

WHAT IS BILL SELF'S NEW SALARY?

ESPN is reporting, citing multiple unnamed sources, that Self will make over \$13 million this year and \$53 million over the next five years (\$10.6 million annually). However figures provided by KU indicate Self will make \$9.2 million this school year, plus an additional \$3.6 million from money previously owed to him, for a total of around \$12.8 million.

Here's how the math shakes out: According to the figures in Self's contract, as reviewed by The Star, in the next year he will make:

- \$500,000 in base salary

WHAT IS BILL SELF'S BUYOUT?

Among the details from Self's amended contract, his buyout to leave for another "competitive" college program — either a Power Five program or a school that has made the Final Four in the last five years — is \$5 million. It will drop to \$4 million starting on April 1, 2026, and \$3 million on April 1, 2027.

Self will owe KU \$3 million if he accepts NBA employment before April 1, 2026, and \$1.5 million if he jumps to the NBA starting on that same day. If Self is fired without cause, KU will owe him \$23.1 million.

In Self's previous agreement, that amount (with firing without cause) was significantly lower — \$5.41 million plus a prorated share of an annual \$2.435 million retention bonus given every April 1.

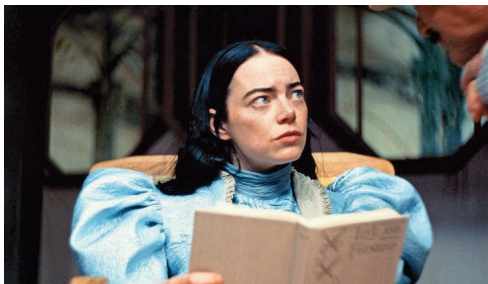



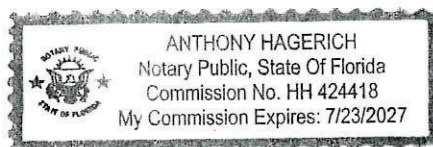

Don't freak over first week

Let's remember our history before we go crazy and flip out over the debut College Football Playoff rankings.

In eight of the nine previous seasons of the postseason format, 15 of the 32 teams listed in the top four of the debut rankings did not make the playoff semifinals. The one exception is the 2020 season, when the coronavirus pandemic pushed the first rankings to Nov. 24 and the top remained the same through selection day on Dec. 20.

Let's remember the first team to ever land at No. 1. Do you remember? That was Mississippi State, which opened 7-0 in 2014 behind quarterback Dak Prescott but was No. 7 in the final playoff rankings.

Don't forget the team that started No. 1 last season. Have you forgotten? It was Tennessee, which held on to the top spot for just one week before dropping to No. 5 following a loss to Georgia.

Things can and will change in November. For now, the top five of No. 1 Ohio State, No. 2 Georgia, No. 3 Michigan, No. 4 Florida State and No. 5 Washington only provides a glimpse into the selection committee's thinking on how the best teams in the Football Bowl Subdivision compare.

Here are the winners and losers from the debut rankings:

WINNERS

Ohio State

Surprisingly, this is just the fourth week the Buckeyes have spent at No. 1 in the playoff rankings, following three weeks in 2019. The decision to put Ohio State on top is largely due to strength of schedule, and in particular two wins that are unmatched by other playoff contenders: No. 11 Penn State and No. 14 Notre Dame. That was enough to offset any gap in game control; the Buckeyes have struggled at times putting teams away, including in last weekend's win against Wisconsin.

Michigan

There was some thought heading into Tuesday night that Michigan could land as low as No. 5, last among the unbeaten teams in the Power Five. At the very least, there was an argument for placing the Wolverines at No. 4 as a reflection on the team's weaker strength of schedule compared to Ohio State, Georgia and Florida State. That they've landed at No. 3 means the committee acknowledges the weak résumé but still agrees on this: Michigan has played like a dominant team regardless of who's on the other sideline.

Even better for Michigan was the way selection committee chairman and North Carolina State athletic director Bo Corrigan said the group considered the program's sign stealing scandal, which has threatened to engulf Jim Harbaugh and the broader season. To be exact, the group didn't really consider the situation at all in regards to the Wolverines, said Corrigan.

"As we went through it, that wasn't really part of any of the discussion that occurred during our time together," he said on ESPN.

"We really view it as an NCAA issue, not a CFP issue. At this point, as we're looking at this, we need to get not only the top four teams but the top 25 teams right."

The Pac-12

In a bittersweet twist in the league's final season of existence, the Pac-12 was recognized by the committee as the deepest league in the FBS. The conference has six ranked teams:

- No. 5 Washington, No. 6 Oregon, No. 16 Oregon State, No. 18 Utah, No. 19 UCLA and No. 20 Southern Cal.
- That half the league's makeup is in the playoff rankings could have the impact of giving the Pac-12 champion and even the runner-up some major credibility in the eyes of the selection committee.

LOSERS

Penn State

Penn State is being docked for a relatively weak list of wins, which includes no teams in the debut playoff rankings and just two teams, West Virginia and Iowa, currently with a winning record. While the Nittany Lions can easily land in the top four by running the table from here – that would include a win against Michigan and another solid win in the Big Ten championship game – there's also the inverse to consider: PSU could be sent hurtling down the rankings with a loss to the Wolverines on Nov. 11.

Air Force

No. 25 Air Force comes in second among Group of Five teams, one spot behind No. 24 Tulane, despite the fact the Green Wave has something the Falcons do not: a loss. As an argument, Tulane has three wins against FBS opponents with a non-losing record and a solid loss to No. 10 Ole Miss. Air Force has time and opportunity to leap ahead with games against UNLV, Boise State and the potential Mountain West championship game. But one thing the committee might be saying by putting Tulane ahead is that the American is a better league than the Mountain West, meaning the Green Wave should keep the Falcons at bay for the rest of the season by winning out.

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GMs brace for Ohtani's momentous decision

SCOTTSDALE, Ariz. — Everywhere you looked, every place you turned, everything you heard, and all you could imagine Tuesday, was all about Shohei Ohtani.

Ohtani was nowhere in sight. His agent, Nez Balelo, wasn't available. And his former Los Angeles Angels boss, Perry Minasian, was talking only in generalities.

Makes no difference. The Ohtani free agent sweepstakes is the epicenter of the MLB general manager meetings at the Omni Resort where an entire industry anxiously awaits the outcome.

"We all involve ourselves and our profession around this game," said Erik Neander, Tampa Bay Rays president of baseball operations, "because we love it. We love talent. We love stories. And certainly, he's as fascinating a talent as we've all seen in our generation."

"Across the game, this is as anticipated a decision as we've had in our sport. This is certainly as captivating one to many, even for people that aren't baseball fans. I think it's great for our game."

Ohtani, who will be honored next week with his second American League MVP award in three years, is the sport's greatest two-way athlete in history, even eclipsing Babe Ruth. He had his second elbow surgery in five years on Sept. 19 and won't be able to pitch again until at least 2025, if not later — but no matter. There's not a team in baseball that doesn't covet him. Even with a price tag that will exceed \$400 million, he's expected to receive the most seven-figure contract offers in baseball history.

Traditionally when a marquee free agent hits the open market, he'll get two, perhaps three legitimate offers. Aaron Judge got offers from only the New York Yankees, San Francisco Giants and San Diego Padres last winter. Bryce Harper's market consisted of the Philadelphia Phillies, Los Angeles Dodgers and Giants. Manny Machado had offers from the Padres and Chicago White Sox.

"I've had a few big-name players, and many times it's just team bidding against themselves," one veteran agent said. "You just don't have many teams willing to make that kind of commitment."

This time is different. Ohtani could have as many as 10 teams making legitimate offers and perhaps as many as 20 that will tell their fan base they were in on him, too.

Simply put, he's the holy grail of free agency in the sports world.

"Just as an industry and fan perspective," Cleveland Guardians GM Mike Chernoff said, "he's the most interesting

story in baseball right now. He's just such a unique talent. I'm trying to think of what guys have had this sort of unique attributes over the years, and I can't think of any.

"He just brings a whole different dynamic just because he's a two-way player. I can't even imagine how that will be valued on the market. I have no idea how it will play out."

There will be big markets and mid-sized markets involved. Teams from San Diego to Toronto to Texas to New York to Chicago will be in the bidding. The only thing guaranteed, GMs say, is that there will be a mystery team, a finalist in the sweepstakes that no one saw coming.

It could be as shocking as the 2000 winter meetings when the Rangers signed Alex Rodriguez to a record 10-year, \$252 million contract, the richest in sports, easily beating out the Seattle Mariners and Atlanta.

"No one knows where he's going to end up," Houston Astros GM Dana Brown said, "and I think that's exciting for the game. You just don't know what's going to happen. I think there may be a wild-card team out there that's going to surface. These teams can just come out of nowhere."

"It's so unpredictable. I mean, like honestly, I didn't even consider the Cubs for (Craig) Counsell. I wasn't even thinking about that. I'm thinking maybe the Mets or he goes back to Milwaukee, and then all of a sudden it's the Chicago Cubs."

"Where these things land is really difficult to predict. In free agency, it's got to be the perfect city, the perfect match and a revenue city that can actually afford him. Only the good Lord knows where he ends up."

Minasian wishes he could wave a magic wand and bring him back. The Angels never reached the postseason during his six years with the team, but he has been the most electrifying player in the game, hitting a league-leading 44 homers with 95 RBI, 20 stolen bases and a career-high 1.066 OPS in 2023 despite missing most of September. On the mound, he went 25-14 with a 2.69 ERA, striking out 386 batters in 298 innings the past two years.

Where else can you find a legitimate ace and one of the game's premier power hitters in one package?

"I don't think the world quite appreciates how hard or challenging this is relative to any other athlete in sports," said Derek Falvey, Minnesota Twins president of baseball operations. "It's like there's no quarterback in the NFL also playing free safety at a high level. It's just very unique. So, I appreciate it just as a fan of baseball."

Said Brown: "He's actually getting the American kids to start thinking about, hey, I can pitch and hit. Remember when guys were drafted they had to choose? Now guys will get an opportunity to say I want to do both."

The Angels may be flawed, but they know they're a whole lot better with Ohtani than without him and truly believe

they have a genuine chance to keep him.

If they wanted to trade him last summer, they could have received at least three top-10 prospects from any contender. Several teams were willing to offer their best and more.

Angels owner Arte Moreno also knew that if he traded Ohtani, he wasn't getting him back. Once Ohtani walked out the door, he was gone forever.

So now they'll take their chances and compete with the big boys. The Dodgers remain the heavy favorites. The Cubs and Rangers are serious contenders, with several GMs saying the Cubs may be the most aggressive team for his services. And it would be foolish to count out the Red Sox, the Mets or even the Giants.

"Great player, I think there's going to be a lot of attention on it," Minasian said. "And I understand why. We'll see how the offseason develops. We've got our plan, and we're going to try and execute that plan and we'll see where everything goes."

The Angels aren't promising a playoff berth with Ohtani, just like the Rangers didn't when they recruited Corey Seager, Marcus Semien and Jacob deGrom, either.

Yet in a baseball world where this year's World Series teams lost 110 and 102 games just two years ago, anything can happen.

"I think this is a very desirable place to play," Minasian said. "It's in a great part of the country. We have an outstanding fan base. The players that have played here since I've been here have been really, really positive with their experiences. So, with anybody on the market, I think we have a chance."

For all those who don't believe Ohtani has any interest in returning, Minasian doesn't blink. The Angels signed Mike Trout to a 10-year, \$360 million contract when folks thought he preferred to one day to play in Philadelphia or New York. They outbid the Miami Marlins and Cincinnati Reds for Albert Pujols in 2011. They persuaded Anthony Rendon to come their way in 2019.

Many of those decisions may have backfired, but it proved that Moreno loves his stars, and he has not backed away from shelling out money, even if it means flying past the \$237 million luxury tax threshold in 2024.

"I wouldn't put anything past," Minasian said. "I think it's something that for the right opportunities, ownership is all about winning. ... We'll do what we can to make the team as good as we can."

So, buckle up, lock the doors, and brace yourself for a seismic impact once Ohtani makes the decision heard 'round the baseball world.

"It's probably the most focused on free agent moment that I can remember," Falvey said. "We'll see how it shakes out."

"Just stay out of the (AL) Central. That's all I care about."
