



APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION. Luminant Mining Company LLC, 6555 Sierra Drive, Irving, Texas 75039, which operates Leesburg Lignite Mining Area, a surface lignite mine, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a renewal of Texas Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (TPDES) Permit No. WQ0004681000, to authorize the discharge of surface water runoff from active mining areas, ground water seepage, and dewatering well water on an intermittent and flow-variable basis via Outfall 001M and post-mining area runoff on an intermittent and flow-variable basis via Outfall 001R. The TCEQ received this application on July 16, 2020.

The facility is located approximately 1.5 miles east of the City of Leesburg, 0.8 miles south of the intersection of County Road 3106 and State Highway 11, in Camp County, Texas 75451. This link to an electronic map of the site or facility's general location is provided as a public courtesy and is not part of the application or notice. The effluent is discharged via Outfalls 001M and 001R to Lamar Branch, thence to North Lilly Creek, thence to Lilly Creek, thence to Little Cypress Bayou (Creek) in Segment No. 0409 of the Cypress Creek Basin. The undesignated receiving water uses are high aquatic life use for Lamar Branch and North Lilly Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0409 are primary contact recreation, public water supply, and high aquatic life use.

The TCEQ executive director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The executive director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, executive director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at Camp County Clerk's Office, 126 Church Street, Room 102, Pittsburg, Texas.

PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting about this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit written or oral comment or to ask questions about the application. Generally, the TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the executive director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING. After the deadline for public comments, the executive director will consider the comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. **The response to comments, along with the executive director's decision on the application, will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments or who requested to be on a mailing list for this application. If comments are received, the mailing will also provide instructions for requesting a contested case hearing or reconsideration of the executive director's decision.** A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in a state district court.

TO REQUEST A CONTESTED CASE HEARING, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR REQUEST: your name, address, phone number; applicant's name and proposed permit number; the location and distance of your property/activities relative to the proposed facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public; a list of all disputed issues of fact that you submit during the comment period; and the statement "[I/we] request a contested case hearing." If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify by name and physical address an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are relevant to the group's purpose.

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the executive director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

The Commission may only grant a request for a contested case hearing on issues the requestor submitted in their timely comments that were not subsequently withdrawn. **If a hearing is granted, the subject of a hearing will be limited to disputed issues of fact or mixed questions of fact and law relating to relevant and material water quality concerns submitted during the comment period. TCEQ may act on an application to renew a permit for discharge of wastewater without providing an opportunity for a contested case hearing if certain criteria are met.**

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ACTION. The executive director may issue final approval of the application unless a timely contested case hearing request or a timely request for reconsideration is filed. If a timely hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed, the executive director will not issue final approval of the permit and will forward the application and requests to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

MAILING LIST. If you submit public comments, a request for a contested case hearing or a reconsideration of the executive director's decision, you will be added to the mailing list for this specific application to receive future public notices mailed by the Office of the Chief Clerk. In addition, you may request to be added to: (1) the permanent list for a specific applicant name and permit number; and (2) the mailing list for a specific county. If you wish to be placed on the permanent and the county mailing list, clearly specify which list(s) and send your request to TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk at the address below.



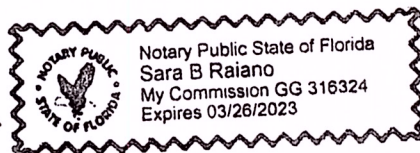

Preparation helped Lotus of Siam blossom in pandemic

LAS VEGAS – Long before COVID-19 shut everything down, Lotus of Siam co-owner Penny Chutima ordered bulk supplies of masks and gloves.

It was January. Coronavirus news was still overseas. Friends thought she was crazy.

“Like one of those conspiracy theorist people,” she said. “They were like, ‘No. Not in America. Nobody in the States will ever shut down.’ So when March came around the corner – boom.”

Lotus of Siam is a Thai restaurant known for its vast menu of north country specialties. What does that mean? This is not a place to get pad thai.

This is the place you visit for a Thai meal you’ve never heard of. Noted dishes include the sa-tay prawns (in any style they serve), stuffed chicken wings and Thai jerky.

Jonathan Gold, a Pulitzer Prize-winning food writer, called Lotus of Siam the best Thai restaurant in the country. “It was the best Thai meal I had ever eaten,” he wrote. “I went back for the next four or five meals in a row, and I almost cried when I had to get on a plane back to New York.”

Taking a bite on his show “Parts Unknown,” chef and writer Anthony Bourdain had this to say: “That’s perfection, man.”

With two locations in Las Vegas, Lotus of Siam has a reputation restaurants envy. COVID-19 threatened to take it all away.

Before the pandemic, the restaurant employed 110 people. Today, that number is about 70. Social distancing, table limits and caution are a way of life for the family that’s operated the restaurant since 1999, when Chutima’s mother – the storied Chef Saipin – took over. In the middle of their toughest year, Chutima’s life changed. She had a baby.

A year after the pandemic collapsed Las Vegas tourism, Lotus of Siam is back to operating both restaurants. The USA TODAY Network talked with Chutima about how they did it and where the restaurant is going from here.

Why she started preparing for the pandemic so early

“My mom was watching the news from Thailand. I had a lot of friends in China on WeChat posting into our feed. A bunch of doctors reported this was something that has no cure.

“They said it was kind of like a pneumonia but worse.”

How Lotus of Siam prepared

“We did our research first, and then my mom told me to order a lot of the masks, because in Thailand they wore masks. We ordered masks. We ordered a bunch of gloves.

“At that time, my mom bought a lot of food items in bulk – coconut milk and

especially rice, because we knew that if anything was to happen, China would close.

“So we ordered a lot of the rice, Thai teas, Thai coffees. A lot of main necessities we ordered in huge bulk.”

On the close-knit family atmosphere at Lotus of Siam

“We have people who have been with us since the beginning. There are people I consider like my cousins, because they’ve been with us 18-19 years. Some of them have master’s degrees. But they’ve all been working for us, and it doesn’t look like they want to leave any time soon. I was there when I was like 12. My sister was about 5 or 6 years old. These people watched us grow, and they brought in their kids, and now we’re watching them grow.”

Whether she notices people feeling more confident about dining out

“The vaccine gives people some sort of confidence that things might get back to normal, but I don’t see things changing with protocol. With new strains being present, sanitation is going to be more strict. Everything that I’ve done so far is probably going to be staying.”

What keeps her positive and moving forward

“That thing (she looks at her daughter). She’s about to be 6 months old. Everybody’s always like, ‘How can you take this restaurant thing so easily and smoothly?’ I feel like I’ve been through every stress in the book – owning a restaurant, helping to manage it, making sure it’s up to my mother’s standards

and at the same time have a 6-month-old. I can handle it now.”

What she’ll tell her daughter when she’s older

“You were born during a pandemic, and we had to be inside (laughs).”

Whether she hopes Las Vegas will see a return to some kind of normal

“I’m a realistic person. Many people will see me as a pessimistic person. But I do see Las Vegas is hopeful. We all just need to work together. It’s not just small businesses and restaurants anymore. Our government officials have to hear us out, too.”

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Time for Arizona to make call on Miller

Through more than three years of allegations and innuendo about whether head coach Sean Miller would be implicated directly in the corruption that infiltrated the University of Arizona basketball program, the school stood by him. No matter how bad the headlines looked for Miller, no matter how much the ongoing NCAA investigation seemed like a guillotine inching toward his neck, Arizona never backed away from a coach who once seemed destined to return the Wildcats to the Final Four.

But now, at the very moment Miller has gained a degree of vindication, Arizona is paralyzed by dysfunction and indecision. With just one year left on his contract, Miller's time in Tucson has reached a boiling point, presenting the school with a choice whether to cut ties now or double down on Miller through the end of its NCAA case.

Instead, according to two people with knowledge of the situation who spoke to USA TODAY Sports on the condition of anonymity due to the sensitivity of the situation, Arizona is doing nothing.

Since Arizona's season ended March 1 due to a self-imposed postseason ban, it has in essence created a standoff designed to either get Miller to walk away from the last \$1.5 million he would be owed if fired or come back next season while the clock runs out on his contract — a situation that practically never happens at the Power Five level.

"There's no communication at all" between Miller and the school's administration, one person with knowledge of the matter said.

Though Arizona President Dr. Robert Robbins stated publicly in recent days that he wants Miller to return as coach next season, he communicated in a brief meeting last week that he couldn't get a contract extension approved by the school's board of regents and left Miller with the impression that Robbins would prefer a parting of ways, according to one of the people, who is familiar with Miller's thinking.

Even if Robbins wants to move Arizona past the Miller era, doing so without alienating some of the school's biggest athletic boosters who are loyal to Miller

or further burdening his cash-strapped athletic department won't be easy.

At this point Miller does not intend to resign, according to one of the people, and the uncertainty over his punishment from the NCAA eliminates him from getting hired elsewhere in college basketball during this cycle.

At the same time, the two people told USA TODAY Sports that Miller is conflicted about a 2021-22 season without some kind of signal of support from the school, even a school-friendly token extension that would be easy to get out of.

Not only would daily speculation about Miller's future consume all the oxygen next season, but recruiting would basically grind to a halt. And with the NCAA about to grant every player a one-time free transfer, there's no guarantee Arizona's current roster — which projects to be in the preseason top 25 — would come back intact. Most coaches would rather just get fired than try to keep that circus together.

It's hard to see the upside for Arizona in that situation. If Miller comes back on the last year of his contract, the smoke clears from the NCAA investigation and school officials decide that keeping him long term is their best option, they've unnecessarily kneecapped his rebuilding job. By the same token, if they let Miller coach next year and then get rid of him, the new coach inherits a depleted roster, no recruiting class and the brunt of whatever sanctions are imposed without the kind of head start in 2021-22 that might be valuable.

Hanging over all this is uncertainty

about when the NCAA is going to rule on Arizona's case. Currently, it's in the hands of the new Independent Accountability Resolution Process (IARP), the off-ramp where complex NCAA cases are handled. But the IARP has been moving at a glacial pace, and there are other FBI-related cases (like Kansas') that are ahead of Arizona in the pipeline. It might take even another year before the case gets resolved.

So here's the part that's hard to figure: If Arizona has come this far with Miller, why would it tuck and run now?

Though the school only made its NCAA Notice of Allegations public Friday after a judge ordered it to be released, Arizona officials have known the scope of the charges for months.

In totality the allegations are heavy, with five Level 1 (most serious) violations, ranging from academic fraud orchestrated by former assistants to former assistant Book Richardson accepting bribes to steer players toward certain agents. It's serious stuff, and Arizona is likely going to end up with significant penalties, particularly given the public pressure on the NCAA to make hay out of the FBI investigation that uncovered all kinds of college basketball corruption.

But the only charge directed at Miller specifically was the catch-all NCAA rule that presumes head coaches are responsible for violations committed by their assistants and failing to monitor Richardson's relationship with Christian Dawkins, the middleman who got caught up in the FBI's sting operation

into college basketball recruiting.

For Miller, just as notable was what didn't appear in the notice.

No mention of Deandre Ayton, who was the subject of an explosive ESPN report in 2018 claiming, according to an unnamed person familiar with the FBI investigation, that Miller was caught on a wiretap discussing a \$100,000 payment with Christian Dawkins. Miller strongly denied that, saying he had "never discussed" paying Ayton with Dawkins.

There was also no mention of point guard Jahvon Quinerly, who decommitted from Arizona after an unnamed player matching his description appeared in FBI documents allegedly accepting \$15,000 from Richardson. Quinerly was later cleared by the NCAA.

There was no mention of Brian Bowen or Nassir Little, players whom defendants in the case said Arizona had been willing to pay for.

There was no mention of the video played during Dawkins' 2019 trial of a conversation with an undercover agent in which Dawkins alleges Miller had knowledge of illegal recruiting.

After all the mud thrown at Miller over the past three-years-plus, what was the NCAA really able to pin on him at the end of the day? Not that much.

To be clear, none of that proves Miller's innocence.

But had Arizona fired Miller the moment that Richardson was arrested, it would have made sense. If it had gotten rid of him when wiretaps started getting played in court and his name started coming up on the witness stand, it would have made sense.

At the time, though, Miller had been to three Elite Eights and two Sweet 16s in his first eight seasons.

Now, with no new evidence against him and a notice that isn't nearly as bad for Miller as many expected, it looks like Arizona is growing cold on him because of his recent record.

The cloud of investigation at Arizona has undeniably made recruiting more difficult. Still, in a perverse way, it's been an impressive coaching job. Arizona went 17-9 this year, playing hard to the end despite no postseason carrot.

After three years of fighting back all kinds of allegations about how its program was run under Miller, Arizona has come to the moment when there's a path toward conclusion. One way or another, it's time for decisions to be made.

actly what kind of an impact COVID-19 would have on the NFL. This time a year ago, the country was going into lockdown and sporting events were getting scrapped. But as free agency kicked off, the NFL still had a six-month cushion before games began, and many assumed the country would have returned to normal by then. But as the games took place in empty or sparsely filled stadiums, the NFL lost an estimated \$3 billion of its usual \$16 billion revenue.

The previous year's revenue determines the salary cap, but the NFL and NFL Players Association had agreed last fall that the salary cap for 2021 would not fall below \$175 million and they would split the losses of 2020 over mul-

multiple seasons. Last month the NFL announced the cap would be no less than \$180M, and many teams, players and agents hoped it would approach \$190M.

So a year after they structured contracts with an initial anticipation of operating under a cap of roughly \$210M, teams now must figure out how to field rosters using about \$28 million less.

"That's a dramatic departure from what the expectations were going to be pre-pandemic," Joel Corry, former NFL agent-turned-CBS Sports analyst, told USA TODAY Sports. "The cap had been going up 5 to 8% each year, so \$210 (million) was a reasonable estimate. ... Nobody contemplated the cap taking a steep drop like it is going to this year."

A number of teams would have found themselves in bad shape even without the depression of this year's figure. When the offseason began, projections had the Saints \$100 million over the cap.

As of Wednesday's announcement, the Saints had released six players, restructured the contracts of seven players and still found themselves roughly \$31 million over the mark, according to OverTheCap.com.

Between now and March 17, the league will see many players released who a year ago would have fallen under that "surprise" cut category. Or teams could try to trade such players. A perfect example is Miami linebacker Kyle Van Noy. Last spring, he signed a four-year, \$51 million contract. But now it appears likely he will be either released or traded to help Miami create roughly \$9 million in cap space.

The coming days also will feature creative moves by contract negotiators. A move made popular by the Saints in previous years and now catching on among others is restructuring deals and tacking additional voidable years onto

contracts to massage salary caps. The Cardinals used this strategy when signing JJ Watt to a deal classified as a two-year pact that actually pays him for longer.

The NFL and NFLPA "allow the voiding dummy years to be used for pro-rata purposes even though they're not real years, and they void the last day of the league year or some specified date," Corry explained. "It's a legal way to cheat the cap until they close it. I expect a number of the guys you see in free agency signing one-year deals on paper are four-year deals that void to one."

As Corry pointed out, young players may find it in their best interests to bet on themselves through shorter deals this year. Older players may benefit from long-term security offered by multiple years.

But for now, teams and players will feel the crunch. The show must go on.

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
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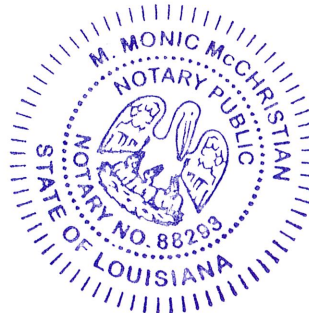
