

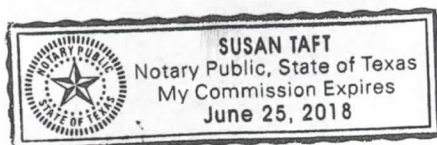

NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION FOR WATER QUALITY TPDES PERMIT RENEWAL FOR INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER

APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION. Luminant Mining Company LLC, 1601 Bryan Street, Floor 28, Dallas, Texas 75201, which operates the Monticello-Leesburg Lignite Mining Area, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for a renewal of TPDES Permit No. WQ0004681000, which authorizes the discharge of surface water runoff from active areas, ground water seepage, and dewatering well water on an intermittent and flow-variable basis via Outfall 001 and post-mining area runoff and previously monitored effluent from post mining sedimentation ponds on an intermittent and flow-variable basis via Outfall 101. The draft permit authorizes the discharge of surface water runoff from active mining areas, ground water seepage, and dewatering well water on an intermittent and flow-variable basis via Outfalls 001M, 002M, 003M, 004M, and 005M and post-mining area runoff on an intermittent and flow-variable basis via Outfalls 001R, 002R, 003R, 004R, and 005R. This application was received by the TCEQ on November 5, 2013.

The facility is located 1.5 miles east of Leesburg, southeast of the intersection of the Kansas City Southern Railroad and County Road 3106, Camp County, Texas. The effluent is discharged via Outfalls 001M, 001R, 002M, 002R, 004M, and 004R to Lamar Branch; via Outfall 003M and 003R to Chaffin Branch; and via Outfall 005M and 005R to an unnamed tributary, thence to Ellison Branch; all outfalls flow to North Lilly Creek; thence to Lilly Creek; thence to Little Cypress Bayou (Creek) in Segment No. 0409 of the Cypress Creek Basin. The unclassified receiving waters have minimal aquatic life use for the unnamed tributary and high aquatic life use for Lamar Branch, Chaffin Branch, Ellison Branch, and North Lilly Creek. The designated uses for Segment No. 0409 are high aquatic life use, public water supply, and primary contact recreation.

The TCEQ Executive Director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit. The draft permit, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The Executive Director has made a preliminary decision that this permit, if issued, meets all statutory and regulatory requirements. The permit application, Executive Director's preliminary decision, and draft permit are available for viewing and copying at the Camp County Courthouse, County Clerk's Office, Room 102, 126 Church Street, Pittsburg, Texas. PUBLIC COMMENT / PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting about this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comments or to ask questions about the application. TCEQ holds a public meeting if the Executive Director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.

OPPORTUNITY FOR A CONTESTED CASE HEARING. After the deadline for submitting public comments, the Executive Director will consider the comments and prepare a response to all relevant and material, or significant public comments. Unless the applicant is directly referred for a contested case hearing, the response to comments will be mailed to everyone who submitted public comments and to those persons who are on the mailing list for this application. If comments are received, the mailing will also provide instructions for requesting a contested case hearing or reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision. A contested case hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in a state district court.

TO REQUEST A CONTESTED CASE HEARING, YOU MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS IN YOUR REQUEST: your name; address; phone number; applicant's name and permit number; the location and distance of your property/activities relative to the facility; a specific description of how you would be adversely affected by the facility in a way not common to the general public; and the statement "I/we request a contested case hearing." If the request for contested case hearing is filed on behalf of a group or association, the request must designate the group's representative for receiving future correspondence; identify an individual member of the group who would be adversely affected by the proposed facility or activity; provide the information discussed above regarding the affected member's location and distance from the facility or activity; explain how and why the member would be affected; and explain how the interests the group seeks to protect are germane to the group's purpose.

Following the close of all applicable comment and request periods, the Executive Director will forward the application and any requests for reconsideration or for a contested case hearing to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

The Commission will only grant a contested case hearing on disputed issues of fact that are relevant and material to the Commission's decision on the application. Further, the Commission will only grant a hearing on issues that were raised in timely filed comments that were not subsequently withdrawn. TCEQ may act on an application to renew a permit for discharge of wastewater without providing an opportunity for a contested case hearing if certain criteria are met.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ACTION. The Executive Director may issue final approval of the application unless a timely contested case hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed. If a timely hearing request or request for reconsideration is filed, the Executive Director will not issue final approval of the permit and will forward the application and request to the TCEQ Commissioners for their consideration at a scheduled Commission meeting.

MAILING LIST. If you submit public comments, a request for a contested case hearing or a reconsideration of the Executive Director's decision, you will be added to the mailing list for this specific application to receive future public notices mailed by the Office of the Chief Clerk. In addition, you may request to be placed on: (1) the permanent mailing list for a specific applicant name and permit number; and (2) the mailing list for a specific county. If you wish to be placed on the permanent and the county mailing list, clearly specify which list(s) and send your request to TCEQ Office of the Chief Clerk at the address below.

All written public comments and public meeting requests must be submitted to the Office of the Chief Clerk, MC 196, TCEQ, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, TX 78711-3087, or electronically at www.tceq.state.tx.us/about/comments.html within 30 days from the date of newspaper publication of this notice.

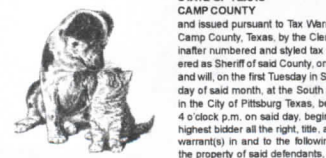

Are rock stars just too cool for social media?

Alloof performers could see benefits if they 'take that mike and work it'

Is there anything more un-rock 'n' roll than rock stars posting selfies and cute baby pictures? The too-cool-for-school attitude that's part of the rocker genetic code might be making it difficult for those artists to embrace social media.

Pop singer Shakira surpassed the 100 million "like" mark on Facebook last month, making her literally the most-liked person in the world. Compare that with 36.5 million likes for Coldplay, 194 million for the Rolling Stones and 17.9 million for U2.

Head over to Twitter, and you'll find that top 40 queen Katy

Perry has 55.1 million followers, an iconic superstar Taylor Swift has 42.3 million. Meanwhile, Imagine Dragons has a mere 1.5 million followers, and Nine Inch Nails, a paltry 296,000.

"Rock rolls to its own beat. They have that *je ne sais quoi*, but they don't work that," says Jessica Northey, a country music blogger who was listed as one of *Forbes'* top 50 social-media power influencers for 2013 and has 588,000 Twitter followers. "Social media is just like performing onstage. Take that mike and work it."

While Shakira shares photos of her baby on Facebook and Madonna shows off her hairy armpits on Instagram, Jack White's only Twitter account is his label Third Man Records, and he's been known to post signs at his concerts that tweeting and posting photos are "strictly prohibited."

Bruce Springsteen has acknowledged that he doesn't write his own tweets. Prince doesn't have a Twitter account. Mumford & Sons guitarist Winston Marshall, with fewer than 4,000 followers, wrote in one of his most recent tweets (in 2013): "Not enjoying twitting. Think I'm done."

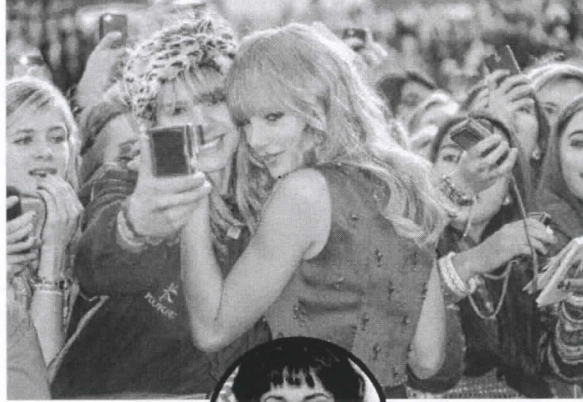
Since Bob Dylan joined Twitter in 2009, he (or more likely, his team) has posted 389 times. Compare that with Perry, who also joined in 2009. She's tweeted nearly 6,000 times.

BANDS VS. SOLO ARTISTS

"Rockers tend to be private with their personal lives. Part of the appeal of the rock image is the mystique and that they're unapproachable," says Brandon Geist, editor in chief of rock magazine *Revolver*. "You can't be a rock god if you're going to take photos of your cup of coffee."

Though rock stars are larger than life, "you don't really know much about them," he says. "However great Prince is musically, he guards his privacy closely, so I can see why he wouldn't be that interesting to follow."

That rock stars tend to be part of a band adds another degree of separation. "Rock bands are like logos. If a logo walked up to you, would you want to hug it?" Northey says. "We want to know the individuals, so solo artists have an easier time than bands. There are more solo artists in

the gift that keeps on giving. "When band members get involved on their Facebook page and sign posts as themselves, it helps fans get to know individual band members better," says Jonathan Hull, who works for Facebook's Strategic Partnerships in Music. "This level of authenticity and personal touch helps grow the overall engagement."

POSTS WITH POWER

Linkin Park, by far the most popular rock band on Facebook, has found its own way to connect. Instead of near-naked selfies and photos of kittens, the members share behind-the-scenes clips from concerts or music video shoots. When their album *The Hunting Party* came out in June, it went No. 1 on iTunes in 67 countries, and Facebook has a lot to do with that, *Halemane* says.

An artist's number of followers and likes don't tell the whole story, either. "You don't have to have a huge following to have a strong influence," Northey says. "But you should give fans something they can't get anywhere else." Neil Young, who has only 174,000 Twitter followers, hosted a Twitter chat about his 2012 album *Psychedic Pill*, and sales jumped from No. 10 on Amazon to No. 5.

Marilyn Manson, who isn't very active on social media, wrote a poignant post on Facebook mourning his mother's death. That May 18 post got more than 100,000 likes. "He doesn't post much, but when he does, they're powerful," Northey says.

The push to join the social media fray doesn't apply to all bands. "The Rolling Stones and U2 are above that. Their emotional connection with their fans has remained steady over time," says Henry Schaffer, executive vice president of the Q Score company, a service that measures celebrity likability.

Still, just as rock acts have accepted streaming music, they'll adapt, too, to social media.

"It is simply the world we live in," Geist says. "Rock will have to embrace it in order to survive." "You can be cool," Northey adds. "But not too cool for Twitter."

SOCIAL MEDIA 101: ADVICE FOR ROCK STARS

Sure, you're famous. But do you know how to be a rock star on social media? Music blogger Jessica Northey, one of *Forbes'* top 50 social-media power influencers for 2013, offers a few tips.

MISTAKES R OK

"Spelling mistakes are good," she says. "Sometimes I do things wrong (on purpose), because then I can tell who's paying attention, and my followers know I'm writing."

DIY

Your publicist shouldn't tweet for you, Northey says. "Fans aren't stupid. They will know it's not you." Country singer Clint Black "does all his own social media. If Clint can do it, why can't rock stars?"

BE ORIGINAL

"You don't have to post constantly, but when you do, make sure it's something that fans can't find anywhere else," she says. Examples: an Instagram selfie with another rock star or an impromptu acoustic tune on YouTube.

PUBLISH OR PERISH

Social media should be both push and pull, she says. "You're not only publicizing your upcoming album, but you're pulling in fans."

BUILD RAPPORT

"At the end of the day, does all this social media turn into sales? If not, then why do it?" Northey asks. "Because it takes time to build that rapport with fans and grow your fan base."


