# Miss Teen USA apologizes for having used racial slur: ‘Now I know how hurtful it is’

For Karlie Hay, the Texan crowned Miss Teen America on Saturday, the victory lap has turned into an apology tour. The 18-year-old spoke with *Good Morning America* host George Stephanopoulos on Tuesday and said she was “ashamed” she used the N-word in several tweets in 2013. Her old posts came to light within hours of her winning the pageant, which chose five blue-

eyed blonds as its finalists. “I am very sorry,” Hay said. “It’s embarrassing. It’s something I’m ashamed of. I’ve grown up from that 15-year-old girl who used that type of language. It’s never acceptable, and now I know how hurtful it is. “It hurts me to know that at one point in my life I used that language. I said that. It’s not me.” She explained that at that point in her life, she was a “follower” trying to fit in with her friends. “The word was thrown around in the music I listened to, with the friends I hung out with, and I

had no guidance. It was kind of a careless mistake. When the tweets got brought back up, I was embarrassed and ashamed and amazed that at one point I thought it was OK to use that word. It’s not OK. There is no excuse to say that word, ever.” Asked how she felt about the move to dethrone her, Hay says she has changed and pledged to “turn this message into a positive message because there are people who use that word and it’s unacceptable.” She added, “Hopefully people will learn from my mistake because it is a big mistake. It’s something that will stick with me.”

# Opportunities expand for women in baseball

ball in America.”

Whitmore was unsure how her new teammates would feel about her, but she was quickly welcomed. They joke and play video games on the clubhouse couch, but she’s also treated like a rookie, expected to carry the helmet bag and batting equipment.

Stompers general manager Theo Fightmaster compared Whitmore and Piagno to Swiss army knives, saying they’ve grown up being versatile utility players, which ultimately will help the team.

“We shouldn’t expect these girls to come in and be the best player on the team, nor should we cheer them when they pop up,” Fightmaster said. “The next step now is they should be able to fail the same way the guys fail, and they should be treated the same when they succeed.”

## THROWBACK IN TIME

The positive response Whitmore and Piagno have had from teammates hasn’t always been the norm. When pitcher Ila Borders signed with the St. Paul Saints in the independent Northern League in 1997, she was one of the first female players in pro baseball.

Borders said it was obvious her teammates didn’t want her around, questioning her motives for playing. Was it a publicity stunt? Did she have an agenda? Was she just trying to pick up guys?

“At first, they were not friendly,” said Borders, who played in the league from 1997 to 2000. “They would push me, they would see what I was all about, and as soon as they saw that I could roll with it and just have fun, then they were my biggest supporters.”

On July 7, 1998, while playing for the Duluth (Minn.)-Superior (Wis.) Dukes, Borders became the first female pitcher to start in a men’s pro game, and, despite the loss, she pitched five innings and gave up three earned runs, five hits, two strikeouts and two walks. Later that season, she re-

corded a streak of 12 scoreless innings stretching over two games.

The reaction from Stompers fans after adding Whitmore and Piagno to the lineup has been largely positive, Fightmaster said.

But for Borders, who played professionally until she was 25, it was the opposite.

People made death threats against her, showed up at her parents’ house in the middle of the night and often would follow her home. But after her teammates began to trust her, they also went out of their way to protect her.

“I could never drive straight home,” Borders said. “I would have to have (teammates) follow me home and take different routes to try to lose people. It was a constant state of danger.”

## HARDBALL VS. SOFTBALL

Creating more opportunities for girls and women to play baseball includes challenging the social norm of girls switching to softball when they age out of Little League. But sticking with baseball, as Whitmore and Borders did, is easier said than done.

“If you’re a 12- or 13-year-old girl and your option is to be the oddball playing with the boys ... or to play softball with your peers and all your friends, a lot of times they make the decision for themselves without the outside pressures,” said Ashley Bratcher, the senior director of baseball operations for USA Baseball. “That’s the age where being socially accepted is important.”

Encouraging girls to stick with the sport, USA Baseball organized a women’s national team in 2004, which plays in international tournaments.

The team competed in the Pan American Games for the first time in 2015, bringing home gold with the help of a no-hitter from Piagno — another first for the team. Whitmore is also on the team, which is preparing for the Women’s World Cup in South Korea in September.

To increase awareness, USA Baseball hosts the National Team Identification Series, which recruits young players to work with the national team and iden-

tifies talent for the future.

An estimated 1,200 girls played baseball in high school in 2015, according to the National Federation of State High School Associations.

But finding them in small pockets across the country and making them aware of the opportunities available remain a challenge, Bratcher said.

“When I go to the national team, it’s a whole different thing,” said Whitmore, an alumna of the identification series. “We all understand each other. We all went through the same things — being the only girl and (growing) up

just wanting to play baseball and always being pushed toward softball.”

## ‘A LEAGUE OF THEIR OWN’

Baseball and softball are viewed as interchangeable sports in the USA. But other countries, particularly Japan, have solid infrastructures, making the distinction between the two sports with baseball leagues for female athletes, from children to professionals.

Aspiring to that standard, Siegal and Baseball For All push to establish a similar platform. While the organization fully sup-

ports coed baseball teams, the big-picture goal is to replicate an infrastructure similar to Japan’s to build national opportunities.

Siegal — who was hired in 2015 by the Oakland Athletics as the first female coach of a major league team — thinks creating equal pathways to baseball is a social justice issue and that a future women’s professional league is impossible without a large number of girls playing at all ages.

Last month, 18 teams and more than 175 players from four age groups hailing from nearly every geographic region converged on San Francisco for the organization’s second national tournament.

“Girls and women deserve to have a league of their own,” Siegal said. “On my end with Baseball For All, we need to have girls playing baseball. We need to support them at a young age and provide true opportunities for them to play this game.”

Next month, Fox will debut *Pitch*, a series about the first big-league female pitcher. Rick Singer, the writer and executive producer, began work on the script not long after Borders’ pro debut.

Nearly two decades later, it will roll out on the small screen, and Singer says believability is a big reason.

“It went from the category of one of those Disney, fantasy-type movies like *Rookie of the Year*, to where it’s now becoming plausible,” Singer said. “That’s one of the great joys for me.”

Borders, 41, works as a firefighter and paramedic in the Portland, Ore., area, but she remains active in the baseball community, coaching high school and college players individually. She’s also an adviser for Baseball For All and is optimistic about the future because of the help the organization gives female players.

“It’s way different (now) than my experience, because people were trying to keep me from playing ball, so we are headed in the right direction,” Borders said. “People are more open-minded, and I think people are more receptive and open to women playing baseball.”

Price also reported the new parking lot concrete contract bids to the board and these bids were also approved by the board and that project can also proceed.

The air conditioning in the elementary school gymnasium has begun and will be completed before the start of school. The heating part will be completed before any cold weather sets in.

School Superintendent Judy Pollan reported to the board that with the extra funds that were saved in the transportation budget because of the low gas prices, she proposed to take advantage and purchase a new bus that

was available at a reasonable price, and the board approved that purchase.

Superintendent Pollan also reported to the board the purchase of a school police four-wheeler to aid the school police officers in patrolling the campus. The vehicle is rigged with police lights, a public address system and other features found on most police vehicles.

The new agricultural building's storm shelter is near completion, lacking only the 8" concrete roof. As soon as that is installed the walls and roof will go on. The interior construction is estimated to be finished in approximately six months or less.

The covered bus drop off and covered walk-way are completed and ready for any inclement weather.
