

# **REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS**

On or about August 24, 2020 the City of Pittsburg will submit a request to the Texas Department of Agriculture (TDA) for the release of Community Development Block funds under Section 104(f) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 as amended, to undertake sidewalk improvements, under TCF Contract #7219272.

Sidewalk Improvements - Construction shall consist of approximately 910 linear feet of sidewalks utilizing 600 square yards concrete, 500 linear feet curb and gutter, 9 ADA compliant ramps, 400 linear feet of sidewalk retaining wall footing, 700 square feet retaining wall, 300 linear feet French drain, fire lane and parking marking, and all associated appurtenances. Construction will take place along College Street from North Avenue (Martin Luther King) to alleyway; North Avenue (Martin Luther King) from College Street to Jefferson Street; alleyway from College Street 150 linear feet south; and south end of new parking area from alleyway 70 linear feet west.

Parking Improvements - Construction will consist of parking and handicap spaces utilizing 725 square yards cement concrete, and all associated appurtenances. Construction will take place along College Street from 100 linear feet east of North Avenue (Martin Luther King) to alleyway.



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

# 'We just have to survive this trip'

# Marlins' motley crew pulls out inspiring win in return

BALTIMORE - They ran sprints down hotel hallways, rolled up sanitary socks into makeshift baseballs and tossed them into mattresses, even stepped around dirty room-service dishes to take part in Zumba classes, all mitigating physical hurdles even if the greater challenge was mental.

For nine days, the Marlins were not a team but rather a grim experiment in pandemic baseball gone wrong, forced into various modes of isolation and quarantine as their luxury accommodations in Philadelphia felt more and more like captivity.

Finally, Tuesday night at Camden Yards, the Marlins returned to a baseball field, but it was almost impossible to deny that this was a team splintered into thirds.

The first team was thousands of miles away: 18 players and three staff members who tested positive for the novel coronavirus and were shipped back to Miami from Philadelphia on sleeper buses, now in isolation and, we can only hope, on the way to recovery.

The second team is what's left of the first, a group the Marlins are calling the "Trece" – Spanish for 13 – a baker's dozen of players who dodged COVID-19 but were forced to isolate in Philly for eight days until they were deemed healthy.

The third team? Just consider them the most motley crew of Marlins assembled in a franchise that knows strange times – a mélange of rookies, waiver claims and trade acquisitions tossed together in a week's time in a madcap attempt to make the roster whole.

Tuesday, the "Trece" and the fresh Fish came together - many of them having never met in person until arriving at Oriole Park – to see what kind of season they might salvage. The results were nothing short of inspiring.

Pitching less than a month after the death of his father, Pablo Lopez - reduced to mattress baseball in his Philly digs - spun five innings of one-hit, scoreless ball against the Orioles.

Veteran catcher Francisco Cervelli punctured the quiet of a scoreless tie with a fifth-inning home run. Three innings later, Jesus Aguilar blasted a ball even deeper over the left field wall. It was his third home run in four games, never mind that the first came nearly 11 days ago

Two innings of one-hit relief were turned in by James Hoyt and Richard Bleier, who manager Don Mattingly did not meet until Tuesday afternoon, as they waited to get their temperatures checked before boarding the bus to the ballpark.

building team, albeit one that improved the Marlins' record to 4-2 – the finest winning percentage in a season when several teams are well past the 10-game mark.

More than that, it was a modicum of relief.

"We've been through a lot," a visibly drained Mattingly said on a postgame video call. "We didn't know quite how we'd react. You get tested and you have to persevere and you learn from a lot of situations. We knew we had a good group of guys. We miss the guys who are gone. We just have to survive this trip."

A trip that was supposed to be one week but is just reaching the halfway point of a 22-day odyssey that cast the eastern portion of MLB's schedule into disarray.

The Marlins must make up seven games after they lost a week of baseball following the nightmare array of positive tests that waylaid their roster. It began the morning of July 26, when starting pitcher Jose Urena, first baseman Garrett Cooper and outfielder Harold Ramos all tested positive for COVID-19, joining catcher Jorge Alfaro.

Miami played and defeated the Phillies that day, a controversial choice to carry on by league and team. But the bad times were just beginning.

Rather than return home, the Marlins got marooned in Philadelphia as positive tests kept spiraling and, ultimately, taking out Nos. 1-2-3 in their rotation -Sandy Alcantara, Caleb Smith and Urena, and seven members of their bullpen.

The hell of the unknown settled over their hotel.

'The lack of not knowing anything," Mattingly said of the mental anguish. "We left the ballpark in Philly, we'd lost four guys, and you think that's it. You plan to leave the next morning. The next morning, the tests come back, awful.

"And then it's Friday back to Miami. And then that becomes Sunday. You knew guys were getting more frustrated with being locked up in a room, being frustrated with all the stuff out there. We have to move on. It's good to get back on the field, move forward, talk about baseball.

Yet still so much had to happen before they could.

## **Makeshift roster**

The avalanche of transactions that occurred Tuesday – 13 players to the injured list, 18 more added to the 40-man or active roster - culminated an unprecedented flurry of pandemic-driven roster activity.

'You never anticipate needing to re-

So Hill activated every corner of his organization, from player development to pro scouts to calling in a few solids from execs around the league. Here's what he came up with:

Not one, but two pitchers named Josh Smith.

An Olympic silver medalist in shorttrack speedskating who'd make his first major league roster at 30, one of four new Marlins who'd yet to set foot on a big league field.

Seven guys off the scrapheap, either claimed on waivers, or recently released, or acquired for "cash considerations."

Tuesday night, somehow, it coalesced.

Aguilar looked like he hadn't missed a beat since the shutdown, and that's no coincidence. He relied heavily on Zumba classes in his room to stay limber and in the eighth inning destroyed yet another baseball, putting the bow on an emotional victory.

"We've been waiting for this moment for 15 days," says Aguilar. "It was a great moment for us.

"A lot of new guys with the same goal, pushing in the right direction. Now, we've got to keep going.

"We have to. We don't got no choice. We've been through a lot."

Indeed, the human element can't be underestimated.

Infielder Miguel Rojas – perhaps the team's best player and its undeniable face – was among those testing positive for COVID-19 and noted in a video call this week the hidden emotional toll.

"It tells you a lot about we're suffering," he said. "We're human beings, not just baseball players. We're suffering from this virus. We've got another 15 teammates that got the virus. This has to bring awareness. Not just to our team but to everybody throughout the league."

Tuesday, Rojas' exuberance could not be contained on Twitter, as he rooted on his mates and most notably Lopez, who had gone nearly 11 months since throwing a meaningful pitch.

Lopez stayed sharp during the fourmonth industry shutdown and looked good early in summer camp. But after the first week, his father died suddenly of a heart attack and Lopez left the team for several days.

Lopez returned to the team by the opener but did not pitch before the hiatus. So he balled up socks and threw into his mattress in his Philadelphia hotel room, just one man on his mind all the while.

"Finding myself alone in my hotel room in Philadelphia, that wore me Jesus Aguilar reacts after hitting a

enjoyed that feeling of someone on my shoulder watching over me.

"He helped me get through that time in Philly, making sure I was doing everything right."

# **Motley crew**

Minus Alcantara, Urena and Caleb Smith, Lopez might be the Marlins' ace by default. It wouldn't be the oddest look on their roster.

The club now counts a 2014 Olympic silver medalist among its ranks: Eddy Alvarez, a 30-year-old rookie outfielder who wowed the club with his versatility in both spring and summer camps.

'Just a tremendous story on stick-toit-iveness, attention to his craft as a professional baseball player," Hill says of Alvarez, a Miami native who spent six seasons in the minors with the White Sox and Marlins after winning silver in the Sochi Games. "Being on the major league roster for the first time at that age is just a tremendous credit to him and his hard work."

Alvarez is one of four Marlins hastily added to the roster who have never played in the big leagues, the other three pitchers Jorge Guzman and Daniel Castano and outfielder Monte Harrison arriving in trades involving Giancarlo Stanton, Marcell Ozuna and Christian Yelich, respectively.

Those deals signaled a teardown and perhaps an eventual strong young core. Now, the Marlins are building back up in a fashion nobody could have imagined.

They can only hope the worst is behind them.

"We've been in the hotel a long time." says Mattingly. "Guys are happy to be out of there. We expect to win, honestly. thinking of him kept me going. I kept It will be a different look. But I think we expect to win."

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# MLS IS BACK TOURNAMENT WINNERS AND LOSERS

# **Orlando surprises; Timbers take title**

The first (and hopefully not last) MLS is Back Tournament concluded with the Portland Timbers prevailing over upstart Orlando City in Tuesday night's finale at the ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex.

Coach Giovanni Savarese's Timbers didn't just win a one-of-a-kind trophy but also earned a spot in the 2021 CONCACAF Champions League competition.

Despite the premature exits of two teams – FC Dallas and Nashville SC – before the tournament started due to positive coronavirus tests, MLS is Back could be considered a success, helping reinforce the idea that sports can be played safely inside a bubble during a pandemic.

As the league moved forward with its regular season restarting (again) Wednesday, here's a look back at the best and worst from the month-long World Cup-style tournament.

# WINNERS

**Orlando City SC:** Orlando advancing to the final was a pleasant surprise for a team that hadn't experienced any success since joining the league in 2015. New coach Oscar Pareja appears to have turned this perpetual loser into a force to be reckoned with. Meanwhile, star player Nani turned back the clock to his former European splendor.

Young American players: The U.S. men's national team (USMNT) might have failed to qualify for the last World Cup, but there's plenty to be excited about with the team moving forward. Young players are breaking through on clubs in Europe's top leagues. There are

also a number of emerging USMNT prospects in MLS. Here are those who impressed the most in Orlando, Florida:

• Ayo Akinola, forward, Toronto FC: The 20-year-old notched five goals in three games and was a breakout sensation in the early portion of the tournament. Akinola is eligible to play internationally for either the U.S., Canada or Nigeria. Having played for the U.S. Under-15, U-17 and U-20 national teams, Akinola has yet to be capped by the senior team.

• Brenden Aaronson, midfielder, Philadelphia Union: The Union's efforts with its developmental academy are starting to pay huge dividends, as Aaronson, 19, and defender Mark McKenzie, 21, have been the topics of Euro transfer rumors.

• Jeremy Ebobisse, forward, Port-

**land Timbers:** The 23-year-old is vital off the field as a key voice in the league's new Black Players Coalition and he performed admirably on it for the winners.

• Eryk Williamson, midfielder, Portland Timbers: The 23-year-old has yet to earn his first USMNT call-up but was a vital cog in the Timbers' midfield.

• Chris Mueller, forward/midfielder, Orlando City SC: Three goals from Mueller, 23, in group play helped power the Lions into the knockout rounds.

• James Sands, midfielder, New York City FC: NYCFC's first homegrown signing, Sands, 20, is another candidate to make a move to Europe's top leagues.

**Black Players Coalition:** Launched on Juneteenth, the efforts of the league's coalition were ubiquitous at the month-long tournament. The Black Players for Change made their first move before Orlando City and Inter Miami played the tournament's opening game on July 8. More than 170 of the league's Black players lined the field, lifting their fists into air in a moment made more powerful by the silence from having no fans in attendance. The statement lasted 8 minutes and 46 seconds to honor George Floyd, who was killed while in police custody in Minneapolis.

# LOSERS

**Frank de Boer:** Atlanta United – a popular pick to contend for the tournament title – crashed out of the competition after three scoreless games. It was a dismal showing for what once was one of the most entertaining teams to watch. After the tournament, Atlanta parted ways with de Boer, and now one of MLS' premier franchises has hit a low point in its brief existence.

Los Angeles Galaxy: The Galaxy managed just one tie at the tournament, and it took a stoppage-time penalty kick to do it in the team's third and final game. That keeps the Guillermo Barros Schelotto-led Galaxy in the cellar of the Western Conference, sitting two points behind FC Dallas, which didn't even get to play at MLS is Back. The low point, of course, was a 6-2 drubbing at the hands of in-city rival LAFC.

**Inter Miami CF:** By losing in its first two MLS games before the league shut down in mid-March, and then going 0-3 inside the bubble in Orlando, Inter Miami earned the unenviable distinction of being the first MLS expansion team to lose its first five games. David Beckham's team is still a work in progress, and help appears to be on the way in 2018 World Cup winner Blaise Matuidi, who has agreed to a deal with Inter Miami according to multiple reports.


Come on guys, really?

"This one kind of hurts," said Cleveland's Terry Francona, returning to manage the team for the first time since missing eight games with a gastrointestinal issue, which along with his hip and back ailments have led to five or six hospitalizations since February, on Tuesday. "We talked about it as a team today. We will deal with it as we always do. We care about each other, but that doesn't mean you don't get disappointed with each other, or mad at each sometimes. Not being vindictive, how do we make it better so it doesn't happen again?" It's the ultimate responsibility to every single Cleveland player and staff member to ensure everyone's safety, relying on everyone to do the right thing. "They hurt us bad," said Adam Plutko, who serves as one of Cleveland's representatives to the MLB Players Association. "They lied to us. They sat here in front of you guys and publicly said



wanted to celebrate.

Plesac, 25, put out a statement Sunday night apologizing for his actions and then doubled down on his remorse on his Instagram post.

"Life can throw some crazy things at you," he wrote, "but how you respond is the testament. What you think is harmless can actually have consequential outcomes...and the lesson learned is this: The most important thing we can do is take care of EACH OTHER. Putting others first, and having the character to understand why there is a greater impact if we are selfless."


