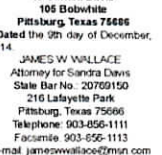

Kelli O'Hara rings in 2015 merrily — at the Met

Waltzes into debut at her 'dream' venue

NEW YORK In 2014, Broadway star Kelli O'Hara earned her fifth Tony Award nomination playing a woman torn between responsibility and passion in the musical *The Bridges of Madison County*. She'll ring out the year in a role that's decidedly lighter in tone.

On Wednesday, New Year's Eve, O'Hara makes her Metropolitan Opera debut in the premiere of a new production of Franz Lehár's 1905 comic operetta, *The Merry Widow*. Directed and choreographed by another Broadway veteran, Susan Stroman, the staging features Renée Fleming in the

title role, a woman who has traveled from Pontevedro (a stand-in for Montenegro) to Paris with an envoy hoping to secure her a match to keep her late husband's wealth in their country. O'Hara plays Valenciene, the ambassador's wife, who attracts another man's attention in the meantime.

Performing at the Met has "been a goal and a dream of mine for years," says O'Hara, chatting in her dressing room at Lincoln Center during a rehearsal break. The actress, 38, received her bachelor's in music from Oklahoma City University, focusing on opera, and several of her musical-theater performances, including those in *Bridges* and 2005's *The Light in the Piazza*, have showcased her classical prowess.

O'Hara is respectful of the differences between the forms. "I understand very well why it's not eight weeks a week" at the Met,

she says. For starters, performers in contemporary Broadway musicals have the luxury of being "mild." "That doesn't have to be a crutch," but in opera "your voice does not have to have as much power as it can on the stage and you have to be as present as you can."

She also credits Stroman, one of a number of leading theater directors recruited at the Met under general manager Peter Gelb, with making the transition to the Met's grand stage seem natural.

"The rehearsal room feels very familiar," she says. "What Susan is doing that is so magical here at the Met is she is using every single person as an individual. ... So every dancer has a trick, and ev-

ery chorus member is waltzing. There's movement; there's a different story going on in every corner of the stage."

Widow wraps its run Jan. 31, but O'Hara won't be away from Lincoln Center for long. On March 12, she begins performances there in a new Broadway revival of *The King and I*, helmed by Bartlett Sher, who directed her in *Bridges* and in Lincoln Center Theater's acclaimed 2008 revival of another Rodgers and Hammerstein classic, *South Pacific*.

"I think it's going to be grand and wonderful and hopefully what everyone wants it to be," O'Hara says of *King*, in which, she notes, she'll play another "strong woman."

For now, though, her focus is on making *Merry* into the new year. "It's so celebratory," she says. "I think it's a perfect fit for this occasion."

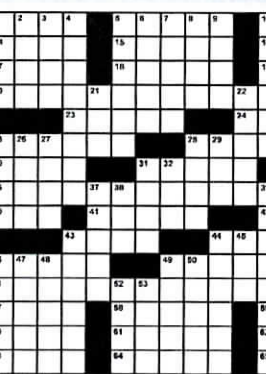

When Liam Neeson is your dad ... look out

Endangered kids are the name of the game in these action flicks

Maggie Grace and Joel Kinnaman share a special, albeit terrifying, bond playing the onscreen offspring of Liam Neeson.

Grace stars as Kim, the daughter of Neeson's CIA operative Bryan Mills, in the *Taken* franchise (*Taken 3* opens Friday), and she spends most of her time in mortal danger.

Kinnaman plays Neeson's grown son, Mike Condon, in *Run All Night* (out April 17), a film that requires him and his hitman dad Jimmy to flee gangsters trying to kill them both.

Grace is noticing a trend. "Yes, Liam's screen progeny are pretty endangered," says the actress, 31. "We all seem to be in peril."

Protecting loved ones is part of the territory for Neeson, 62, who has turned into an unlikely action star. Kim's kidnapping in 2009's *Taken* sent Neeson's character on a gangster killing spree to free her from human trafficking. The film reaped \$145 million at the box office, and Neeson's action-star persona was sealed.

In 2012's *Taken 2*, Kim had to help fight off more gangsters, who kidnapped her mother and Mills. Naturally, there's even more daughter disturbances in the third installment.

Grace believes Neeson's sincerity allows moviegoers to accept him as a father figure, despite being there's a sense of paternal protection about him. He has this presence, like the father everyone wishes they had," Grace says. "He

has a sense of strength but tenderness."

Run All Night director Jaume Collet-Serra says the family angle

becomes an instant target for screenwriters.

"When you want to activate a badass character, most scripts try to go there and do something against the family," Collet-Serra says. "Especially the kids."

Run All Night has a different premise because Kinnaman, 35, is 6-foot-2 and has starred in his own action films, including *Ho-Cop*. He delivers plenty of body blows, and naturally, he needed Neeson about who was tougher.

"I teased him a lot," Kinnaman says. "And I would remind him that he might be stronger, but I run a lot faster."

Nonetheless, Kinnaman has advice for any actors who might be cast as Neeson's progeny: "They should come to work armed and look over their shoulder a lot. Because if they get the part it must mean someone's already after them."
