ORDINANCE NO. 2024-031

TO ENACT CHAPTER 4 RELATIVE TO GEOPHYSICAL AND

SEISMOGRAPHIC SURVEYS, sECTIONS 510 and 511 RELATIVE

TO MOBILE HOME PLACEMENT and CHAPTER 7, RELATIVE

TO PERMANENT GENERATORS AND TO AMEND SECTION 252

RELATIVE TO ADJUDICATION OF VIOLATIONS AND APPENDIX A

RELATIVE TO FEES OF TITLE 8 AND to PROVIDE FOR RELATED

WHEREAS, the St. George Council desires to amend and re-enact Section 252 of Title 8 relative to the adjudication of violations of Title 8.

BE IT ORDAINED by the St. George Council, State of Louisiana, Chapter 4, Geophysical and Seismographic Surveys, Sections 510 and 511, Requirements for Mobile Home Placement, and Chapter 7, Permanent Generators of Title 8, are hereby enacted and Section 252 and Appendix A, Schedule of Fees of Title 8 are amended and re-enacted, as follows:

Section 1. Enactment

MATTERS

Title 8. BUILDINGS Chapter 4. GEOPHYSICAL AND SEISMOGRAPHIC SURVEYS

Sec. 8:400. Permit required.

BY COUNCILMEMBER MONACHELLO:

No geophysical or seismographic survey shall be performed on property owned by the City without a permit.

Sec. 8:401. Approval of plans.

No geophysical or seismographic survey shall be performed on property owned by the City without a permit.

Sec. 8:402. Application fee.

The application fee for each geophysical or seismographic survey permit is set forth in Appendix A to Title 8.

Sec. 8:403. Violation

Any person violating the provisions of this Chapter shall be subject to a fine as provided in Sec. 8:252 of this Title. Each location and each day shall be a separate violation.

Chapter 5. HOUSE MOVING

Sec. 8:510. Requirements for mobile home placement.

Any mobile home to be located within the City after the effective date of this Section shall be required to be parked and located on a solid concrete pad at least four inches thick with the concrete pad extending beneath the entire length and width of the mobile home. The mobile home shall have skirting installed around the entire exterior of the mobile home and shall have no exposed tongue. In addition, any mobile home to be moved and located within the City after the effective date of this Section shall be required to have all exposed sewage and electrical hookups located at the rear of the mobile home so as not to face the portion of the property visible from the public street or right of way on which the mobile home is located.

Sec. 8:511. Application fee.

The application fee for each mobile home permit is set forth in Appendix A to Title 8

Chapter 7. PERMANENT GENERATORS

Sec. 8:700. Permit required.

No permanent generator shall be installed without a permit.

Sec. 8:701. Approval of plans.

The application fee is set forth in Appendix A to Title 8

Sec. 8:704. Approval of subdivision association.

If the applicant seeks to install a permanent generator within a residential subdivision, the applicant shall obtain approval from the subdivision association, if required, prior to applying for a permit.

Sec. 8:705. Generator placement.

Permanent generators shall be installed no closer than the minimum clearance required by the generator manufacturer for any structure. All permanent generators installed shall be installed at or above the highest finished base flood elevation of the existing structure and shall not encroach into a servitude.

Sec. 8:706. Permit for natural gas-fueled and diesel-fueled generators.

A plumbing permit, issued to a licensed plumbing contractor, shall be required if the generator is fueled by natural gas. The applicant for the natural gas generator shall provide the gas utility provider with the existing load on the building or house and generator fuel consumption rate to determine the natural gas line and meter sizing. An applicant seeking to install a diesel-fueled permanent generator shall submit approval of the state fire marshal with the application.

Section 2. Amendment to Title 8, Chapter 2, Sec. 8:252. Sec. 8:252, as adopted in Ordinance No. 2024-015, is hereby amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Sec. 8:252. Violation penalties.

Any person, firm, corporation or agent who violates any provision of this Title, or fails to comply therewith, or with any of the requirements thereof. or who constructs, alters, demolishes or moves any structure, in violation of the approval granted to this Title shall be fined not less than \$50, nor more than \$500.

Violations of any provision of this Title may be enforced by the City pursuant to the administrative procedures set forth in Title 4 of the Code of Ordinances

Section 3. Amendment to Appendix A. The Council hereby amends Appendix A to Title 8 to add the following:

(3) Minimum permit fee shall be \$250.

(4) The building permit fee shall include the cost of trade permits and initial inspections during normal business hours. General contractor to buy permit and trade applicants must sign permit.

Section 4. Conflicts. This Ordinance and Schedule of Fees shall supersede any and all other fees for the items included herein. Any fee not amended by this Ordinance shall remain in effect. All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance and Schedule of Fees are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication

Athletic report lists potential free agent (and trade) options for Kansas City Royals

The Kansas City Royals are working through different scenarios at the 2024 Winter Meetings in Dallas, Texas.

The club would like to add more offensive firepower to their lineup. Royals general manager J.J. Picollo is focused on adding a bat in the middle of the order. Ideally, the Royals would like a player with positional versatility.

Over the weekend, there was an interesting report in The Athletic. Per MLB insiders Ken Rosenthal and

Will Sammon, the Royals are rumored to be seeking a left-handed bat. The report named a few freeagent options such as outfielder Jurickson Profar and infielder Josh Rojas.

The report also mentioned New York Mets infielder Brett Baty as a trade option and a possible reunion with veteran infielder Adam Frazier. But, no deal has reportedly been discussed between the Mets/Royals.

Profar is a big name on the free-agent market. He is a switch hitter who posted a .280 batting average with 24 home runs and 85 RBIs last season. The Royals could be interested in his versatility with experience playing second base, shortstop and the outfield.

However, Profar will be in demand. Several teams that missed out on signing Juan Soto could turn their attention toward Profar and similar free agents. The Royals, who have been active this offseason, could be decide to go in a different direction if the price increases.

Rojas was non-tendered by the Seattle Mariners. He has struggled in recent seasons, but was productive with the Arizona Diamondbacks earlier in his career. At his best, Rojas

can offer value across the diamond.

The Royals are likely to explore the trade market. There are a few names that have drawn their interest in recent weeks. KC has reportedly checked in on third baseman Alec Bohm and outfielder Taylor Ward.

Bohm, who attended Wichita State University, offers the power potential the club is seeking within their lineup. Bohm was a 2024 All-Star after hitting .280 with 15 home runs, 44 doubles and 97 RBIs with the Philadelphia Phillies.

The Royals were reportedly interested in Ward for a while. He was a potential in-season trade candidate in July. The Royals could decide to reconvene discussions as the offseason continues.

Last season, Ward hit 25 home runs and drove in 75 **RBIs with the Los Angeles** Angels. He posted a .748 OPS (on-base plus slugging) and can play an outfield spot.

With any potential trade, the Royals must decide which players they are willing to deal. The club dealt Brady Singer for Jonathan India and Joey Wiemer due to starting pitching depth.

If another trade is on the horizon, the Royals have a few options among prospects. Top prospects include catchers Blake Mitchell and Carter Jensen and pitchers Ben Kurdna and Blake Wolters.

That said, it's unlikely the Royals will deal any of those prospects. The Royals also won't move No. 1 prospect Jac Caglianone.

So, the Royals might have to get creative to make a trade. However, the team has shown the ability to fill needs without sacrificing top prospects. This offseason could be another opportunity for Picollo to manage the future while building a playoff contender.

ROCKY COLAVITO, 1933-2024

Former MLB All-Star slugger dies at 91

Rocky Colavito, an All-Star slugger for three teams in the 1950s and 1960s, died Tuesday at age 91.

The Cleveland Guardians announced that Colavito died at home with family at his side in Bernville, Pa.

In 14 major league seasons with Cleveland (1955-59, 1965-67), the Detroit Tigers (1960-63), Kansas City Athletics (1964), Chicago White Sox (1967), Los Angeles Dodgers (1968) and New York Yankees (1968), Colavito hit 374 homers and drove in 1,159 runs in 1,841 games.

The corner outfielder produced a .266 career batting average with a .359 on-base percentage and a .489 slugging percentage. He finished in the top 10 in AL Most Valuable Player voting four times.

Colavito tied for the American League lead with 42 home runs in 1959 and topped the AL with 108 RBIs in 1965. He was an All-Star for Cleveland in 1959, 1965 and 1966; for Detroit in 1961 and 1962 and for Kansas City in 1964.

"Our collective hearts ache at the passing of Rocky," Guardians senior vice president/public affairs Bob DiBiasio said in a statement. "Rocky was a generational hero, one of the most popular players in franchise history. His popularity was evident across Northeast Ohio as sandlot ballplayers everywhere imitated Rocky's on-deck circle

routine of kneeling, then as he stepped into the batter's box the stretching the bat over the shoulders and pointing the bat at the pitcher. I can proudly say I was one of them.

"Rocky loved our organization and always held the fans in the highest esteem. He would always say, 'I am thankful God chose me to play in Cleveland.' We send our most sincere condolences to the entire Colavito family, as well as his many teammates and other organizations impacted by his passing."

Colavito left Cleveland the first time as part of a historic trade. He was the reigning AL homer champ when he was dealt straight up to Detroit for reigning AL batting champion Harvev Kuenn on April 17, 1960. The teams faced each other two days later in the season opener, won by Detroit 4-2 in 15 innings as Kuenn went 2for-7 and Colavito finished 0-for-6.

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LPGA, USGA change transgender policies

The LPGA and U.S. Golf Association have announced changes to their transgender policies, effective for the 2025 season. The policies, which were announced in tandem on Wednesday, prohibit athletes who have experienced male puberty from competing in women's events.

Hailey Davidson, a transgender athlete who competed in the second stage of LPGA Qualifying in October, fell short of an LPGA card but did earn limited Epson Tour status for 2025. She became the second transgender golfer to earn status on the developmental circuit. Bobbi Lancaster earned status in 2013 through Stage I of LPGA Q-School but never competed in an official event.

The LPGA's new policy states that players whose sex assigned at birth is male must establish to the tour's medical manager and expert panel that they have not experienced any part of male puberty, either beyond Tanner Stage 2 or after age 12 (whichever comes first). They must also maintain a concentration of testosterone in their serum below 2.5 nmol/L.

An LPGA statement read in part: "The policy – informed by a working group of top experts in medicine, science, sport physiology, golf performance and gender policy law – was developed with input from a broad array of stakeholders and prioritizes the competitive integrity of women's professional tournaments and elite amateur competitions. This working group has advised that the effects of male puberty confer competitive advantages in golf performance compared to players who have not undergone male puberty."

The LPGA's updated policy extends to the Ladies European Tour, Epson Tour and any elite LPGA competitions.

"Our policy is reflective of an extensive, science-based and inclusive approach," outgoing LPGA Commissioner Mollie Marcoux Samaan said in a statement. "The policy represents our continued commitment to ensuring that all feel welcome within our organization, while preserving the fairness and competitive equity."

Under these guidelines, Davidson, who played men's golf at Wilmington, an NCAA Division II school in Delaware, before transferring to the men's team at Christopher Newport, a Division III school, would be ineligible. Davidson

began transitioning in 2015 and had gender reassignment surgery in 2021.

In August, the Independent Women's Forum sent a letter to the LPGA, USGA and IGF (International Golf Federation) signed by more than 275 female golfers that called for the organizations to repeal all policies and rules that allow biological males to compete in women's events.

The USGA's new policy, now called the Competitive Fairness Gender Policy, largely mirrors that of the LPGA with only minor differences.

Golf's new transgender rules align with those of World Aquatics and the World Athletics Council, which oversees track and field. In June, transgender swimmer Lia Thomas lost a legal challenge against World Aquatics that argued its policies were discriminatory. In 2022, Thomas became the first transgender athlete to win an NCAA Division I title.

"It was all based on competitive fairness as the North Star," USGA CEO Mike Whan told Golfweek of the process. "Right or wrong, let's be able to look ourselves in the face and any competitor in one of our women's events in the face and say if you're in this event, nobody has a competitive advantage relative to their gender."

Recently retired LPGA player Amy Olson, a former USGA champion, has been one of the few publicly vocal players about the need for organizations to return to a female-at-birth policy. Olson told Golfweek in October that she was cautiously optimistic that the tour would do the right thing.

"There are people, human beings in the middle of these situations that it effects," she said. "I wish that it could've been dealt with before there was a face and a name involved."

Scheffler credits '23 Hero as springboard to big '24

NASSAU, Bahamas – Scottie Scheffler's three-shot victory at the 2023 Hero World Challenge proved to be the perfect springboard into this season. The world No. 1 won seven times on the PGA Tour, including his second Green Jacket at the Masters, and was the gold medalist at the Paris Olympics. He's confident that this week at The Albany could spur another sublime season.

"It's good being back here in the Bahamas. It's always a fun tournament for us to come play in," he said. "I think it's a good warmup for the year, kind of see where everything's at. Kind of come down here, compete, have some fun in the Bahamas and get ready for the next season to start."

But after such a tremendous season, Scheffler was asked what he's been working on during his offseason.

"Just the same stuff I've always been working on," he said. "After I take a bit of a break it usually takes me a little while to make sure my swing is in a good spot. I wouldn't say bad habits but just to make sure my swing is in a place that I like it and then to continue to just enhance the stuff that I've been working on the last couple of years."

Last year he added a new putter before the Hero and was in the early stages of working with putting coach Phil Kenyon. He topped the field in the putting stats at the Hero and his work with the short stick made great strides in 2024, improving from No. 162 in strokes gained: putting last season to No. 77 this year. Will there be any equipment changes for next season?

"No, '24 went pretty well," Scheffler said. "Getting better isn't something that happens overnight. It takes a lot of time and I still feel like there are areas that I can improve upon without making drastic changes to the DNA of what I do."

Why mess with success? During Scheffler's pro-am round on Wednesday, tournament host Tiger Woods, who isn't competing this week, popped out to watch Scheffler and the two chatted on and off between shots. Asked what the two discussed, Scheffler showed his humorous side and deadpanned, "Most of the time we just talked about money and how the purses need to be bigger. Today we really grinded on the Ryder Cup and how it's just such BS that we've never gotten paid. Tiger was really frustrat-

ed, he feels like he hasn't made enough money in his career. I feel the same way; I feel like last year I didn't get paid enough for what I did. Mostly that, just a bunch of griping." Laughter ensued before Scheffler made the point that he's never played golf for money.

"I played golf because I love the game. I love competition. My motivating factor has never been more money, and I feel like I think there's a lot of stuff in this life and in this game that you can do for money and I've never been one of those players that has gone out and seeked to try to build the best business brand for myself," he said. "What I love is I love coming out here and competing and playing golf, I go home and love living my life. I play because I love the competition."

Could there be another successful title defense this week? He faces a 20man field, which is weaker than in past years – just three of the top 10 players in the world are playing here this week (Scheffler, Ludvig Aberg and Wyndham Clark). Then there's the fact that in his past 12 no-cut tournaments, he has five victories; no one else has more than one.

"His consistency has been absolutely absurd," NBC Sports commentator John Wood said. "Sometimes that can take a lot out of you. When you're there every single week the pressure builds and it's exhausting."

But given Scheffler's otherwordly ball-striking it wouldn't surprise Wood to see him remain the dominant player.

"That's the one thing that travels," Wood said referring to Scheffler's precision in hitting fairways and greens. "The fact that he hits the ball so well makes me believe he can have as good if not a better year (in 2025)."

Five most overpaid assistant coaches

'Tis the season for college football coaches hirings and firings.

Or maybe it's more accurate to say it used to be the season for coaches hirings and firings.

The college football landscape looks dramatically different in 2024 than it did just a few years ago. With the advent of NIL and booster-run collectives, coupled with looming revenue sharing, schools have started to shift their focus when it comes to how they dole out money for winning football teams.

In the past, the highest earners on teams were coaches – by a long shot. And while that's still true for now, schools are starting to prioritize putting money toward their roster as opposed to their coaching staff.

How else do you explain Florida coach Billy Napier hanging on to his job when the Gators had amassed a 4-4 record midway through the season? In a statement that likely portends the future, Florida athletic director Scott Stricklin told fans on Nov. 7 that Napier would continue as UF's coach amid speculation that he was about to be shown the door. (Napier's buyout is more than \$26 million.) USA TODAY NETWORK columnist Blake Toppmeyer described it as a "flimsy endorsement." The Gators have since become bowl eligible, but the reality is that to build a program that can contend for College Football Playoff berths, Florida needs to spend its money on top prospects; it also knows stability goes a long way with recruits.

Often at this point, with bowl season right around the corner, underachieving coaches would be looking for work. So far this year, there have been just four Power Four openings – North Carolina, UCF, Purdue and West Virginia - and there are now two left after UCF rehired Scott Frost and Purdue hired UNLV's Barry Odom.

But numerous programs already are reevaluating what assistants are making, and a handful already have been shown the door.

USA TODAY Sports analyzes the five

most overpaid college football assistant coaches:

(Fired coaches were not eligible for the list, though getting paid to do nothing – like former Florida State defensive coordinator Adam Fuller - would qualify as peak overpaid. Tony Gibson took the job as head coach at Marshall after the season ended.)

1. Blake Baker, LSU, defensive coordinator

Compensation: \$2.5 million

Good golly, this guy could make an argument to take up all five spots. Consider that Baker, 42, is the highest paid assistant in the country ... and his team finished the regular season 8-4. Worse, he is presumably being paid \$2.5 million to put together a stout defense, but the Tigers rank 52nd – 52nd! – in total defense. Surely being ranked that low contributed to their 5-3 finish in the SEC and another missed playoff opportunity under head coach Brian Kelly. Giving up 38 to Texas A&M and 42 to Alabama, both losses, is a good way to make this list.

But it's even worse when you remember that LSU paid Missouri \$950,000 to cover Baker's buyout when it hired him in January. Add that LSU owed his predecessor Matt House about \$3.7 million and, well, accountants in the Tigers athletic department can't be happy. (House was hired by the Jacksonville Jaguars as an inside linebackers coach, which offset some of his buyout.)

2. Tony Gibson, N.C. State, defensive coordinator

Compensation: \$1.5 million

Did you know the 6-6 Wolfpack had one of the highest paid assistant coaches in the country? Yeah, we're as perplexed as you. Gibson, in his fourth year at North Carolina State, was being paid a lot of money to put together a top defense. But the Wolfpack finished the regular season ranked 84th in the country and barely made a bowl game. Gibson, who may have felt some pressure to move on, probably is taking a pay cut to be head coach at Marshall.

Compensation: \$2 million

Well, this is awkward. Not only is Scalley overpaid when you consider Utah's abysmal year - the Utes missed a bowl game for the first time since 2013, finishing 5-7 – but in the summer, Utah revealed that Scalley is the coach-inwaiting whenever Kyle Whittingham steps down. The Utes did not rank higher than No. 30 in total defense. Yikes.

Andy Ludwig, another candidate for this list considering his \$2,050,000 salary, resigned as the Utes' offensive coordinator in October. While it's true many of their problems this year go back to a banged-up roster, the reality is, if you're going to make \$2 million annually, you need to be playing in the postseason annually, too.

No. 4 Chip Kelly, Ohio State offensive coordinator

Current compensation: \$2 million

Win the one game you're supposed to win (vs. Michigan) and you don't make this list. Continually lose that game especially in a year when you are absolutely the more talented team - and people are going to start looking hard at payroll. Chip Kelly has long been considered one of the more brilliant offensive minds in college football and while his offense isn't as innovative or unstoppable under head coach Ryan Day, it should at least be able to hang more than 10 points on OSU's biggest rival.

No. 5 Wink Martindale, Michigan, defensive coordinator

Compensation: \$2.3 million

This one is a little tricky. Defending national champion Michigan finished the regular season ranked No. 15 in total defense, which isn't terrible, but also isn't good for one of the highest paid assistants in the country - especially when you consider that Martindale returned to the college ranks after making headlines with his NFL defenses, particularly with the Baltimore Ravens. Martindale is due for a substantial raise (\$200,000) each year of his three-year contract, which runs through Jan. 10, 2027.

It's worth pointing out that a lot of the Wolverines' problems go back to former coach Jim Harbaugh, who jumped ship for the NFL in late January, which put Michigan in a bind. Still, when you add it up for Martindale, it doesn't look good for someone whose team is 7-5, a considerable tumble for the 2023 titlist. Of course, beating your archrival during a season when you have no business doing so always makes fans and administrators appreciate you more.
