





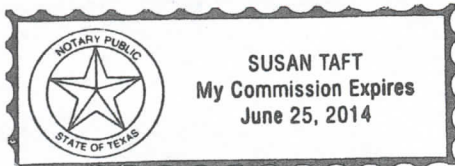

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PRIOR ORDINANCES CONCERNING WATER RATES FOR THE CITY OF PITTSBURG
WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Pittsburg has reviewed water rates in the City of Pittsburg; and
WHEREAS the City Council is of the opinion that the City of Pittsburg should amend existing ordinances to provide modified water rates for customers of the City of Pittsburg;
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PITTSBURG, AS FOLLOWS:
SECTION 1. That the Ordinances of the City of Pittsburg concerning water rates shall be amended as follows:

- Appendix A: Fee Schedule
- (a) **Inside city.**
(1) Minimum water rate, 0 - 1,000 gallons: \$15.00
(2) All over 1,000 gallons: \$4.50 per thousand.
- (b) **Outside city.**
(1) Minimum water rate, 0 - 1,000 gallons: \$23.00
(2) All over 1,000 gallons: \$5.25 per thousand.

Kia sings music from the Soul

Five pop-themed versions take the stage at SEMA

LAS VEGAS Kia put a soundtrack to its hot little Soul crossover here on Tuesday to show the potential for personalizing the boy car — and to show a connection with pop music.

It unveiled five music-themed customized Souls at the Specialty Equipment Manufacturers Association (SEMA) show — the big annual event for aftermarket auto parts makers that attracts all the major automakers, too, with custom machines.

"The music connection to Soul has been well established since the beginning," says Scott McKee, a Kia spokesman.

Kia's five cars included:
► **Amped Soul.** A version from *Popular Mechanics* with blacked-out windows and "larger-than-life" JBL speakers, making it a "boom box on wheels."

► **Vans Warped Tour Soul.** This one has a 50-inch TV on the roof and speakers built into the sides. A gas barbecue grill pulls out from the rear hatch.

► **DJ Booth Soul.** A DJ can pop out of the roof at a moment's notice. It has a Pioneer sound-mixing system and rides on oversize 19-inch wheels.

► **Music Memorabilia Soul.** Created by *Rides* magazine, it includes a signed Slash guitar, a G-Unit sneaker signed by 50 Cent, a Jimi

Hendrix gold album and a signed John Legend microphone.

Honda Civic changes become annual event

In what is starting to seem like an old-fashioned annual model change, Honda lightly freshened the outside of the Civic for 2014.

The Civic coupe, in particular, has been given a little more personality with a new grille, a more pronounced front fender line and new wheel designs. In back, there are new taillights.

The Si performance version of the Civic also gets upgrades to "make it more aggressive, more sporty," says Sage Marie, a Honda spokesman.

The announcement was made in conjunction with the SEMA show here, not a usual venue for automakers' showroom models. It's also unusual because Civic received a major update a year ago after the present generation had only been on sale about a year.

At the time, Honda acknowledged that it hadn't expected competitors' designs to move so far, so fast, and portrayed the update as evidence of its ability to make significant changes quickly.

Toyota sends FJ Cruiser out with special model

Toyota sends the FJ Cruiser into oblivion with a special limited-volume model called the 2014 TRD Teams Ultimate Edition Cruiser, which was unveiled at the SEMA show.

It's due in January at a price not yet announced, and just 2,500 will be built. The FJ is being discontinued worldwide after the 2014 model, and Toyota says the Ultimate Edition is intended to let it go out with bang.

Ford creates Hot Wheels custom Transit Connect

Ford is the latest automaker to create its own Hot Wheels vehicle, this time a customized 2014 Transit Connect small van that was shown here.

There's something about the Mattel toy cars that keeps automakers wanting to turn the toy into the real thing. Maybe it's Hot Wheels' popularity, with 4 billion sold since the line was created in 1968.

"The Hot Wheels design team jumped at the chance to hot rod a Transit Connect van. The idea was to create a race-inspired support vehicle for the average guy to spend a weekend at the track testing his Hot Wheels race car," said Felix Holz, vice president of creative for the Mattel Wheels Division.

Custom builders Ice 9 Group worked with designers from Ford and Mattel to create the flashy Transit Connect, which has the wheels wider in back and three TVs inside.

National cruises to top spot in J.D. Power ranking

Enterprise Holdings' three rental car brands — National, Enterprise and Alamo — sweep the top three spots for satisfaction among airport customers, a survey of customers released Tuesday by J.D. Power finds.

It's the second consecutive year Enterprise Holdings' three brands finished at the top. National, which was No. 2 last year, ranks No. 1 this year, and Enterprise, which held the top spot last year, now ranks No. 2. "Enterprise Holdings is very much focused on the customer experience," says Rick Garlick, the global practice lead at J.D. Power. "Their employees need a certain level of customer satisfaction to be rewarded and promoted, and, at every single touch point during the rental process, they ask you how was the customer service."

National "leapfrogged the other brands," scoring 809 on a 100- to 1,000-point scale, Garlick says. It is a 21-point increase over its score last year — the biggest year-over-year increase of any brand.

Garlick attributes much of National's increase to satisfaction with its reservations policies and a policy of allowing frequent renters to choose their vehicles in the rental lot.

"Receiving an award rated by our customers is the highest honor we could receive," Enterprise Holdings CEO and President Pam Nicholson says in a statement.

Hertz, a favorite of business travel-

ers, ranks No. 4 in customer satisfaction among eight brands in the survey.

Dollar Rent A Car finishes last, and Thrifty Car Rental is next to last.

In July, the Federal Trade Commission gave final approval to a \$2.3 billion acquisition of Dollar Thrifty Automotive Group by Hertz Global Holdings.

Hertz did not comment about the survey. Neither did Avis Budget, which owns Avis, ranked No. 5, and Budget, ranked sixth.

The J.D. Power survey — conducted online September 2012 through August 2013 — is based on 12,382 evaluations of auto rental customers at North American airports.

It looks at six factors to evaluate overall customer satisfaction: costs and fees, pickup process, the rental car, return process, reservation process and shuttle bus or van service.

The survey also finds that customers throughout the auto rental industry are more satisfied with the rental companies than they were last year — or any year since the survey's current methodology was adopted in 2006. Overall customer satisfaction averages a record 775, compared with 769 last year and 767 in 2006.

Customers on personal or leisure travel are slightly more satisfied, on average, than business travelers, the survey finds.

Frequent business traveler Dave Army of Prescott, Ariz., is a customer satisfied with most aspects of renting a vehicle. He says, "Renting a car has never been easier online."
