Leadership expert gives Curry high marks

OAKLAND, Calif. – From his home that is less than a 30-minute drive from Oracle Arena, Ted Ma, a self-described leadership expert, has kept tabs on one of the most successful leaders in the Bay Area, if not the entire country.

A leader who wears high-tops rather than wingtips.

A leader who performs occasional chest bumps at work.

A leader whose skills will be on display when the Warriors play the Raptors on Wednesday in Game 3 of the NBA Finals.

That would be Steph Curry, who is a quintessential leader despite his baby-face looks and soft-spoken nature. Ma, who said his perspective on leadership comes from building an international sales team of over 6,000 independent agents, said Curry’s leadership skills involve three areas.

Accepting a secondary role

When Kevin Durant joined the Warriors before the 2016-17 season, Curry was the team’s leading scorer and top option on offense. Then, without public complaint, Curry accepted his role as the team’s second option.

Durant won the NBA Finals MVP each of the last two seasons, and when Curry was asked about it, Ma noted, Curry said he puts team goals ahead of personal accolades.

“Putting the goal before the role and willing to be No. 1 at No. 2,” Ma said, adding that selflessness is an important leadership trait.

No excuses

During Game 2 of the Western Conference semifinals against the Rockets, Curry badly dislocated the middle finger on his left hand. He offered no excuses after the game, in which he was 3-for-13 from 3-point range. And he offered no excuses after Game 3, during which he shot 7-for-23 from the floor in an overtime loss.

“I think that helps create a standard (for the team),” Ma said.

“Steph leads with his example, his work ethic, his humility,” Warriors coach Steve Kerr said. “The players all love him. They love playing with him. They appreciate him so much.”

Ready for the big moment

In the closing seconds, Curry wants the ball. In fact, in 2013, he told ESPN The Magazine that among clutch closers, “(Michael) Jordan’s No. 1, I’m No. 2.”

Maybe not. But Curry’s self-confidence underscores the key trait.

Said Ma: “The best leaders are not only the ones that perform well under pressure, but those that seek the moment where the win is on their shoulders.”

So what does Curry have to say about leadership? Like on Sunday night, when the Warriors found themselves without not only Kevin Durant, but also Klay Thompson.

“Nothing changes,” he said. “Stay consistent with my approach every year, whether it’s in training camp or in the Finals, everything in between. Just trying to boost confidence, create the right perspective going into each game.

“And we do it by committee. There are a lot of different voices that we have that we rely on. Myself, Draymond (Green), Shaun (Livingston), Andre (Iguodala). Even K (Kevin Durant) when he’s able to provide his input, even when he’s injured and going through his rehab and stuff like that.

“We all just understand the moment and we’re very locked in and focused on adapting to the circumstances that are thrown at us right now with a lot of injuries and kind of uncertainty of even who is going to be able to play. We have been through a lot, had a lot of different

experiences. This is just adding to that book. So we have to be ready.”

Curry’s coach has been impressed with how his star has handled the past few weeks.

“I think with the injuries, where he’s grown is his awareness, his understanding of what needs to happen, what he needs to do when other guys are out, just sort of game management stuff,” Kerr said.

“But he’s always been the same person. I think that’s the beauty of Steph. He doesn’t change. He’s a rock. Our guys lean on him all the time.”

Raptors coach explains use of high school ‘D’

OAKLAND, Calif. – The Raptors were struggling late in Game 2, and coach Nick Nurse searched for ways to slow down Golden State’s offense.

So he employed an unusual defense used mostly in elementary and high schools and rarely in the NBA: a box-and-one defense designed to limit Warriors star guard Steph Curry.

What is a box-and-one? It’s a scheme in which four players are in zone defense — two near the top of the key and two near the basket — and one player defending another player, usually a great player or scorer, man-to-man.

The goal: prevent that player from beating you.

“I don’t remember ever seeing it in the NBA,” Golden State coach Steve Kerr said.

The box-and-one, a gimmick in the NBA, actually worked. Toronto got back in the game with defensive stops, and its offense found some rhythm. Golden State won, but after weathering an impressive Warriors’ run, the Raptors trailed by just two points with 26.9 seconds left.

“I was like, ‘Hey, I’m thinking about going box-and-one. What do you guys think?’” Nurse said Tuesday. “And they were like, ‘Well, what does that look like?’ I drew the box up and who would be where. They kind of liked the looks of Marc (Gasol) and Kawhi (Leonard) being down and Kyle (Lowry) up and Fred (VanVleet) chasing. Kyle was kind of the one that said, ‘Yeah, man, that will work, let’s go.’”

It’s a sign of respect for the offensive player who gets special attention.

“In ninth grade a team played one against me. Very proud to announce that. I had a box-and-one, just like

Steph,” Kerr said, joking.

Curry called it a janky defense, meaning inferior and held in low regard.

“Everybody’s making fun of me for it, right?” Nurse said.

But if it works, so what, and in the NBA Finals, a coach pulls out of his bag whatever is necessary.

“We played some zone during the regular season, and usually you do it

when the game is funky and there’s a bad rhythm and maybe you can change it just by slowing them down or stopping some of their cutting or whatever,” Nurse said.

“It seemed to protect the rim better for us and stop some of their cutting. And it was good. I don’t know, I was just trying to come up with something to stop them.”

It was effective in part because the Warriors were also short-handed. Kevin Durant missed the game with a strained calf, and Klay Thompson missed the final 7:59 of the fourth quarter with a mild hamstring pull.

“Klay definitely wasn’t on the floor at that time,” Leonard said. “There’s no telling when KD’s going to come back either. So I don’t think it will work.”

The Warriors are without Durant for Game 3 and Thompson is questionable, so maybe the Raptors will use it again on Wednesday.

The Raptors used the box-and-one on Golden State’s final eight possessions and confounded the Warriors, who went scoreless on seven of those possessions with VanVleet chasing Curry all over the court and not giving him much space. Curry might have been dismissive of the janky box-and-one, but he didn’t score in the fourth quarter.

The one play the Warriors scored against the box-and-one? Andre Iguodala’s final 3-pointer, which gave the Warriors a 109-104 lead. But go back and look at that play. Leonard almost came up with the steal, and it took a phenomenal, underrated pass from Shaun Livingston to Iguodala.

“I don’t know the numbers or whatever it was, but it was pretty innovative,” Lowry said. “The first time a team has probably ever played box-and-one in the NBA ever. So you give Nick Nurse credit for that.”

10. ‘When They See Us’ (Netflix)

Director Ava DuVernay turns her camera to the so-called Central Park Five in this miniseries, an unflinching look at the experience of the five black and Latino teens who were wrongfully convicted of the 1989 rape of a jogger in Central Park. DuVernay’s blunt style, coupled with performances from the exceptional young actors makes “Us” hard to watch but impossible to miss.

9. ‘The Good Fight’ (CBS All Access)

“The Good Wife” spinoff remains one of the only TV series that properly articulates our current era of anxiety, and not just because it continues to rip its stories from the headlines. The new season is an even wilder ride than the two that came before it, adding Michael Sheen as an unhinged lawyer and sparing no one from its satire – not even former CBS head Les Moonves. It’s worth subscribing to All Access just for “Fight.”

8. ‘Shrill’ (Hulu)

The biggest problem with Aidy Bryant’s sitcom is that there isn’t enough of

it. The first season of the series, based on the memoir by fat acceptance activist Lindy West, is a treasure, full of promise wedged into the six episodes Bryant had time to film between “Saturday Night Live” seasons. The series, in addition to being an honest portrayal of what it’s like to be a fat woman, is a charming relationship and workplace drama that turns Bryant into a star.

7. ‘Superstore’ (NBC)

NBC’s “Superstore” is the rare sitcom to get better with age, and its fourth season found a brilliant story to tell, with Amy (America Ferrara) promoted to manager just as her friends and former coworkers begin to discuss unionizing. With a deep bench of comedic talent, the series could go on for years to come.

6. ‘Killing Eve’ (BBC America)

The first season of the BBC America drama was a surprise hit for the network, a critical darling and the beginning of a career resurgence for Sandra Oh. The new season proves it wasn’t a fluke and finds a way to expand its story beyond a simple tale of MI-6 cat (Oh) and assassin mouse (Jodie Comer).

5. ‘What We Do in the Shadows’ (FX)

The brilliance of “Shadows” isn’t a

surprise for fans of the cult 2014 mockumentary about feckless vampires in New Zealand upon which it’s based. The story is seamlessly translated into half-hour episodes by original directors Jemaine Clement (“Flight of the Conchords”) and Taika Waititi (“Thor: Ragnarok”), who invent new but equally bumbling vampires to cause chaos in Staten Island, New York.

4. ‘Chernobyl’ (HBO)

HBO’s account of the 1980s nuclear disaster in the Soviet Union could have been a rote historical drama, a simple re-telling of a tragedy that has become a buzzword. But “Chernobyl” does so much more than give a dry history lesson. Horrifying and fascinating in equal parts, the series is a searing indictment of the lies, corruption and incompetence that led to the tragedy.

3. ‘Dead to Me’ (Netflix)

With a duo of outstanding actresses (Christina Applegate and Linda Cardellini), an electric script and twists that manage to shock in a jaded era, “Dead to Me” is one of the best new series of the year, and one of Netflix’s best ever. Applegate in particular shines in the tragicomedy about two women who meet in a grief support group and become irrevocably tangled in each other’s lives. “Dead” recently was renewed for a second season.

2. ‘Leaving Neverland’ (HBO)

This year has been filled with documentaries that give voices to victims of alleged abuse, from “Lorena” to “Surviving R. Kelly.”

But even in this context “Neverland” stands out for its sensitive and harrowing portrayal of trauma in telling the story of two men, Wade Robson and James Safechuck, who have accused the late pop icon Michael Jackson of sexually abusing them when they were boys.

1. ‘Fleabag’ (Amazon)

The second season of Phoebe Waller-Bridge’s “Fleabag” is a monumental achievement, the closest thing to perfection that television has gotten in years.

In just six episodes, Waller-Bridge, who wrote and stars in the series, brings comedy, romance and blistering tragedy to life, somehow managing to best her brilliant 2016 first season. The new episodes find Waller-Bridge’s nameless protagonist falling for a Catholic priest while questioning her own self-worth and ability to love in the process. The actress and writer has said that this is the end of “Fleabag,” and although the final episode concludes the story gorgeously, it’s hard to accept that there isn’t any more of this wonderful series.
