# LSU's top pass rushers will play in big game

BATON ROUGE, La. - Six games in two seasons.

That is how many times LSU's two best pass rushers - outside linebacker K'Lavon Chaisson and inside/outside linebacker Michael Divinity Jr. - have played at the same time since 2018.

Chaisson, who leads the team with 6½ sacks this season in 12 games, and Divinity, who led the team with five last season in 12 games and has three in five games this season, will be on the field at the same time for the first time since Oct. 26 on Monday for the national championship game.

Chaisson, a redshirt sophomore from North Shore High in Houston, had a sack in the opener against Miami in 2018, but he missed the rest of the season with a knee injury suffered in the fourth quarter of that game and was granted a medical redshirt. He had two sacks in three starts and 12 games as a true freshman in 2017. He has 9½ sacks in his career.

Divinity, a senior from John Ehret High in New Orleans, has missed nine games this season with injuries and suspensions, including the last six on suspension for team drug policy violations. He has nine sacks in his career.

The last time Chaisson and Divinity were on the same field was Oct. 26 against Auburn when they started as bookend outside linebackers. Chaisson had six tackles with a quarterback hurry, while Divinity had four solo stops with a sack in LSU's 23-20 win.

"We're going to be some fanatics," Chaisson said. "It's going to be great."

Without Divinity on the outside opposite Chaisson, LSU has started a variety of defensive backs on the other edge, such as JaCoby Stevens, Kary Vincent Jr. and freshman Cordale Flott. Linebacker Damone Clark started the national semifinal win over Oklahoma. And freshman defensive back Maurice Hampton has played more in Divinity's absence.

Divinity started Game 2 and Game 4 at inside linebacker, but Patrick Queen has taken over that position well with 10 consecutive starts.

If Divinity does not start at the other outside linebacker spot Monday, he will come in for passing situations to pressure and contain versatile Clemson quarterback Trevor Lawson, who ran for a 62-yard touchdown in his team's 29-23 win over Ohio State on Dec. 28 in the other national semifinal. He rushed for 107 yards in all on 16 carries and completed 18 of 33 passes for 259 yards and

two touchdowns to tailback Travis Etienne of Jennings.

"Mike has been a tremendous pass rusher for us," LSU coach Ed Orgeron said. "I know we're definitely going to use him. We'll see what fits best. We'll definitely use him in the best situations we can."

Orgeron compared Divinity's return from suspension to a free agent acquisition in the NFL or a player returning from injury.

"It boosts your whole team up," he said. "I've got to give Mike credit. He fought through it. He went through some tough times. He went through adversity, but he stuck at it. Now, he gets to play in the national championship game in his hometown.

"What a tremendous boost, especially in our pass rush. We're going to play him as much as we can."

Chaisson's job, meanwhile, just got

"It's kind of going to set everything free," Chaisson said. "So, you've got two great pass rushers now. And even if we're not rushing, people have got to account for us, and probably send some other players. Then watch us drop.

Chaisson figures Clemson will not double-team or try to chip - partial block – both outside linebackers.

"I don't really have to worry about too much pressure on me or worry about chip blocks," Chaisson said. "If they chip me, then Divinity's going to win his one-on-one regardless. I feel like he's going to win nine times out of 10. Even though he hasn't been in games, he's been working and practic-

# Key play vs. LSU in 2012 jump-started Clemson

Fourth-and-16 led to conversion to power

CLEMSON, S.C. - Tales of athletic accomplishments tend to grow taller over time, and that's just fine with Tajh

His career-defining completion to DeAndre Hopkins - known simply in Clemson lore as "Fourth-and-16" - is becoming more impressive by the

"Fourth-and-16 actually gets longer every time, man," Boyd said. "I had a guy run into me the other day and was like, 'Hey, that fourth-and-22 was awesome!

"I said, 'Yeah, let's keep stretching it

By the time Clemson's former All-American quarterback and Atlantic Coast Conference Player of the Year is old and gray, "fourth-and-16" might be "fourth-and-40," but it's not stretching the truth to conclude that Boyd's late-game connection with Hopkins represented a turning point for the Clemson program.

Hopkins' reception led to a 37-yard field goal by Chandler Catanzaro as time expired, lifting the Tigers to a 25-24 victory against LSU in the 2012 Chick-fil-A Bowl.

With Clemson and LSU set to meet for the first time since that game on Monday night - this time with a national title at stake - memories of that watershed triumph eight years ago have been rekindled.

The upset of LSU not only showed that Clemson could run with the big boys but also helped salve the wounds inflicted by a 70-33 loss to West Virginia in the Orange Bowl a year earlier.

"We needed a statement win like that to show that we were ready to compete at that level against major programs," Boyd said.

Catanzaro said it was a triumph that exorcised plenty of demons.

"I feel like we were doubted for so long," Catanzaro said. "But that changed things. The 'Clemsoning' term was being thrown around quite a bit back then, and it was our chance to take down a big dog in the SEC. It's probably the best team win I've ever been a part of."

"Clemsoning" was a term used to summarize Clemson's knack for regularly losing games in which it was favored; although LSU was favored,

Clemson's upset of the nation's ninthranked team and subsequent successes helped quell the moniker.

Gage Cervenka, a graduate guard on Clemson's current team, vividly recalls watching the upset unfold.

"I think the biggest thing that stood out to me was they never quit. They just kept fighting," Cervenka said. "I just remember jumping up in front of the TV and celebrating. It was a great game to

program take a step forward. And we've just kept it going and trucking and trucking and trucking."

"It was incredible to see the whole

Clemson is 13-4 against Southeastern Conference opponents and 90-9 overall since that fateful victory.

Clemson has played at least one SEC opponent in addition to in-state rival South Carolina nine of the past 10 years, including games against Georgia, Auburn and Texas A&M as well as four postseason games against Alabama.

Clemson also has future games scheduled with Georgia (2024, 2029) and LSU (2025, 2026).

"To see the expansion of what has come from that game is really special," Boyd said. "I said a few years I thought this would be a 10-year run, but hey, it might even be longer than that. Clemson is on top and is going to continue to be on top."

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# Known for defense, Jazz rising with offense



A slow start is nothing new for the Jazz. They started last season 18-20 before finishing with 50 victories. They were 20-28 in 2017-18 and ended up 48-34. Even an 8-8 start in 2016-17 concluded with a 51 victories.

So when the Jazz started this season 13-11 while trying to incorporate newcomers Mike Conley Jr., Bojan Bogdanovic and Emmanuel Mudiay into Utah coach Quin Snyder's complex offensive and defensive schemes, no one was surprised. That's just how the Jazz are.

"We made a lot of changes this offseason, and we knew it was going to take some time," center Rudy Gobert

This season, the Jazz have figured it out earlier than in previous seasons, especially offensively.

The Jazz are the hottest team in the NBA. Since Dec. 10, they are 15-1, including 10 consecutive victories, and have moved from sixth place in the Western Conference to second with a 28-12 rec-

"We just feel like we're more connected now," Gobert said. "We know the mo-

game. We know how to find each other. We play for each other. We're moving the ball, and everyone is the beneficiary

"We knew that our margin of progression was huge, and it still is. We knew we had to keep working, staying together, and we knew we had the weapons to be a great team. We know we can be a lot better, too."

While the Jazz are known for their defense - they are eighth in defensive efficiency - this streak is fueled by offense. In the past 16 games, Utah has the league's top offense, producing 118.6 points per 100 possessions.

Guard Donovan Mitchell is playing at an All-Star level (24.2 points per game, 46% from the field), Bogdanovic is mentum of the game, the flow of the shooting 41.1% on 3-pointers, Joe Ingles

43% on 3's and Gobert is shooting 67.6% from the field.

"I'm just trying to find my spots," said Bogdanovic, who has eight games with at least 30 points this season. "Obviously, we run a lot of set plays for me. It was easy and quick for me to adjust to this system."

Mudiay has provided reliable scoring, and Jordan Clarkson, acquired in a trade with Cleveland on Dec. 24, is an offensive boost off the bench. The Jazz are high on Georges Niang, who is developing into a quality 3-point shooter.

"It's amazing for us to have this unselfish group," Bogdanovic said. "We have a lot of ball-handlers who are willing passers and then we have a lot of good shooters around the perimeter, then Rudy is one of the best rollers in the league and he gives us space and opportunity to attack."

Earlier in the season, opponents tried to jam Gobert on pick-and-rolls, and it allowed defenses to guard shooters better at the 3-point line. The Jazz made slight tweaks to where Gobert sets screens, how he rolls to the rim and where shooters are positioned. It has led to better shots and improved offense.

"Our spacing wasn't great a lot of times," Snyder explained. "It's a been real emphasis for us, trying to generate 3's. Are they in transition? Are they under the pick-and-roll? Are they handoffs? There's different ways to get 3's, and that's something we've tried to focus on because every guy is a little bit different."

During this hot streak, the Jazz haven't played the most difficult schedule. The Clippers are the only team with a winning record they have beaten. Still, wins are wins, especially on the road.

Plus, they won all but one of their past 15 games without Conley, who is injured. There is no question he struggled at times, but there is no reason to doubt his ability to figure it out. Switching teams after spending his first 12 seasons with Memphis was a significant change for Conley.

"You want it to happen as quick as possible," Ingles said. "You want it to happen in preseason or before that. With our team, it's taken a different amount of times every year. I don't know what our record is post-All-Star break, but it would be pretty good I would imagine.

"It's obviously happening quicker this year than it has in the past, and we're obviously pumped about that. We'll have a better record heading into All-Star, and if we can continue to improve the way we're improving, we're setting ourselves up for a good year."

Good enough to live up to expectations this team has for itself? Good enough to hang with the Lakers, Clippers and Nuggets in the playoffs? That's what we're waiting to see.

# WNBA players get more pay, family benefits

WNBA players wanted higher salaries, better family benefits and improved travel accommodations.

They got all three in an eight-year collective bargaining agreement that was tentatively reached between players and the league Tuesday.

It's not often two sides in professional sports are equally bullish on CBA agreements. But that was the message delivered by WNBA commissioner Cathy Engelbert, who said, "the time is now for women's sports," and Women's National Basketball Players Association president and Sparks forward Nneka Ogwumike, who said the league and players made "meaningful improvements in working conditions."

The agreement aims to make the WNBA a thriving and sustainable business model for teams and players and one that will create growth and opportunities for future generations.

The improvements are significant, and while it's certainly a win for the

players, it might also be a win for the league, which is betting on its players (their on-court talent and off-court marketability) to help create revenue streams that will benefit both sides.

Engelbert, who was the first female CEO at Deloitte, is ambitious and determined to make that happen. She wouldn't have made this deal if she didn't believe there is money out there for the WNBA. She is a fierce advocate for the players and already is making deals.

The league also announced the WNBA Changemakers program, which will bring businesses together, including one new sponsor, and provide financial and value-driven support. Engelbert pointed out 1% of global corporate sponsorship dollars go to women's sports. Obviously, there is room for the WNBA to secure more.

Pay has been an issue – and we've seen this issue play out in women's soccer – and there is now a commitment that will raise the average cash compensation salary to \$130,000. The top players can earn a max salary of \$215,000 an increase from \$117,000 - with the possibility of reaching more than \$500,000 in compensation from marketing agreements and bonuses.

There is also the possibility of players getting a 50-50 split of league revenue similar to the agreement between the NBA and its players - if the league reaches certain monetary bench marks through broadcast agreements, marketing partnerships and licensing deals starting in 2021. That would also push salaries higher.

As important as the compensation is, the family benefits are just as important and maybe even more so when it comes to personal life.

Players will receive full salary while on maternity leave, up from 50% of their salary, and receive a \$5,000 stipend for child care. Apartments, which are provided by teams, will include two bedrooms for players with children, and there will be "safe, comfortable and private" workplace accommodations for nursing mothers. Also included: up to \$60,000 reimbursement for veteran players for adoption, surrogacy, oocyte cryopreservation or fertility/infertility treatment. There are also significant mental health/well-being initiatives for

Were there concessions? Yes. Players must report to training camp on time, meaning players on European teams will have tough decisions to make. It's common for WNBA players to also play in Europe to supplement their income, but with the league trying to elevate its position with corporate sponsors, fans and potential fans, it needed to make itself the top priority for players. It's an agreement the players understood was necessary to reach short- and long-term

The NBA and by proxy the WNBA have promoted themselves as progressive leagues, and this deal delivers on that point.




