

## **Report: Ruggs driving 156 mph in crash**

Josh Peter

NFL wide receiver Henry Ruggs III was driving 156 mph and had a blood alcohollevel of 161 – twice the legal limit in Nevada – prior to the fatal crash early Tuesday morning, according to prosecutor Eric Bau-man, the Las Vegas Review-Journal reported from Ruggs' court appearance Wednesday morning at the Las Vegas Justice Court.

Judge Joe Bonaventure said he cannot recall a Sugg Joe Bonaventure said ne cannot recan a speed that high in his career on the bench, according to the Las Vegas Review-Journal Review and television reporter Hector Meija, who works for 8 News Now, the CBs affiliate in Las Vegas. A preliminary investigation by the Las Vegas Metro

Police Department indicated Ruggs' Chevrolet Cor-vette crashed into the rear of a Toyota RAV-4, which vene clastice and the feat of 100 a forwar, which then caught on fire. The body of a woman was discov-ered inside the Toyota. Ruggs, 22, and a female passenger were taken to a hospital and treated for non-life-threatening injuries,

while the driver of the other car was killed. At the court appearance Wednesday, the judge set bail at \$150,000 – the state requested bail be set at \$1 million – with an electronic monitoring program and

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ordered Ruggs to abstain from alcohol and other controlled substances. Meija

 and other controlled substances, Mejia reported. Ruggs also was ordered not to drive and to surrender his passport, according to Mejia.

 Ruggs, who was released by the Raiders after the accident, will be charged with DUI resulting in death, which under Nevada law is a Class B felony. A conviction on that charge carries a sentence of two to 20 years in prior

years in prison.

Mejja eported that attorney David Chesnoff, who is representing Ruggs, said, "What we have is a young man who has never been in trouble before" and he re-quested bail of between \$100,000 and \$150,000. After his release by the Raiders, Ruggs is now a free agent and can sign with any of the other 31 teams. However, he also could be placed on the commission-er's exempt list under the NFL's personal conduct or substance abuse policies. *Contributing: Steve Gardner*

### Panthers QB Darnold expected to miss four to six w

Already struggling through a stretch of poor play, Panthers quarterback Sam Darnold now is seeing his season get

even tougher. Darnold suffered an incomplete frac-ture in his right (throwing) shoulder blade and will miss four to six weeks

blade and will miss four to six weeks with the injury, Panthers coach Matt Rhule confirmed i Wednesday. Carolina is coming off of a 24-6 loss Sunday to the Patriots in which Darnold completed 16 of 33 passes for 172 yards with no touchdowns and three intercep

With no touchdowns and three intercep-tions. He posted a QB rating of 26.3. One of those interceptions came late in the third quarter when the game was still within reach – Carolina facing an eight-point deficit at the time – and was returned 88 yards by cornerback J.C. Jackson for a New England touchdown.

On Monday, Rhule said that Darnold reported having soreness after the game and added that Darnold would have an MRI. Rhule also faced questions about whether he would commit to Darnold as the team's starter, given the quarterback's struggles.

"I think right now we're focused on him and his health," Rhule said Monday. "Those of us at the game, we know, and Sam would be the first to tell you, that wasn't good enough from the quarterwash t good enough from the quarter-back position. We had guys open with some opportunities we weren't able to connect on. Too many batted balls, can't happen at this level, and obviously three giveaways. When you look at our season, when we've protected the football, son, when we ve protected the football, we've had a chance to win, and when we've given the ball away multiple times, we all know the results .... "In terms of where we are moving for-ward and all those things, we'll always

try to do whatever it takes to be great try to do whatever it takes to be great. I'm not going to get into hypotheticals and all those things. I kind of handle things one bit at a time. See where Sam's health is, and then make the best decisions after that."

Darnold, 24, has completed 59,5% of his passes for 1,986 yards with seven touchdowns and II interceptions, which is tied for most in the NFL with Bengals quarterback Joe Burrow. Darnold has also rushed for five touchdowns this

Carolina's backup quarterback is P.J. Walker, who became known for his standout play in the XFL over the late winter of 2020. On Sunday, the Panthers (4-5) will play the Cardinals (8-1). talized player, but ESPN and NFL Net-work reported that it was offensive line-man Dakota Dozier. Dozier, who is vaccinated, was placed on the reserve/ COVID-19 list last Friday

Dozier is now in stable condition, ac-cording to Zimmer, who said the situa-

## MVP finalist Soto changed mind on vaccine



CARLSBAD, Calif. - Nationals All-Star outfielder Juan Soto, who tested

positive for the coronavirus a year ago and resisted getting vaccinated, changed his mind after listening to medical experts and said Tuesday that he is now fully vaccinated. Soto, one of the three finalists for the

National League MVP award, said he re-ceived the Pfizer vaccine several weeks ago. He hopes to increase awareness in ago. He hopes to increase awareness in his Dominican Republic community, along with his peers in MLB, that it's perfectly safe to be vaccinated while also advocating flu shots. "At the beginning, I won't lie to you," Soto told USA TODAY Sports, "(the vac-cines) came out really quick and people were scared about it. But at the end of the day universe at to trut our dentem

the day, we've got to trust our doctors. It's crazy how good they are and how much they care about the community. We got to trust our lives with them. "But at the beginning, yes, I was a lit-

tle scared."

Soto played the entire 2021 season without being vaccinated. He said he was concerned about potential fertility visues but was put at ease when talking with doctors who explained there has been no evidence to support such issues

"I was always thinking about (start ing) a family, but they told me how this will protect me and my family and ev-erything," Soto said. "I'm a guy that is al-ways flying in and out of different countries, so I wanted to protect my commu-

Soto says he hopes to help convince his teammates and peers that the vaccines are safe. There were 12 members cines are safe. Inere were 12 memoers from his team who tested positive for the coronavirus in July, including four players, which forced the postpone-ment of a game against the Phillies. "Definitely, I will talk to them and try to availate them how investorit it is."

to explain to them how important it is," Soto said. "But at the end of the day, they are grown-up men and people. I want everyone protected.

"I still wear my mask everywhere I go, Istin wear my mask everywhere 1go, but I feel more comfortable going to places, and I don't care if somebody is coughing next to me." Soto, while hoping to be a role model off the field, has certainly provided plenty of evidence of his impact on the

field. He hit .313 with 29 home runs, 95 RBI and a .999 OPS this past season and led the league with a .465 on-base percentage. He has a career slash line of 301/432/550. His numbers dwarf those of Fernando Tatis of the Padres, who received a 14-year, \$440 million

The Nationals have declared they want Soto to be the face of the organiza-tion and hope he spends the rest of his career with them. Still, it's a business. And Soto says he

has yet to be presented a deal to per-suade him to sign on for a decade or more without testing the free agent market.

Soto, who has finished among the top 10 in the MVP race in each of the past
