

If government were a business, it would close

Opinion: Spread the blame for problems

If you or I ran our businesses the way the Democrats and Republicans run this country, we would be out of business. And deservedly so.

In normal times, it is easy, sport almost, to complain about Washington. But these are not normal times, this is not normal dysfunction, and the end result is anything but normal. Consider:

- GDP, the value of goods and services produced in the U.S., fell by 33% last quarter.
- As of last week, 13.2 million Americans had continuing unemployment claims (representing those still receiving unemployment checks.)
- 76% of small businesses have been either severely or moderately negatively affected by COVID-19, according to the most recently published U.S. Census Small Business Pulse survey.

Let's start at the top because, in both business and politics, the buck starts – and is supposed to stop – there. But no, not with President Donald Trump. According to him and his staff, they have done a terrific job managing this pandemic, he went so far as to tell Bob Woodward: “Nothing more could’ve been done.”

Nothing more? We small businesses beg to differ.

Let's do a thought experiment for a moment: Say that you are running a business and your accountant came to you last January and said, “We are about to lose our biggest contract. As a result, come this spring, our company is going to face a severe cash crunch. In fact, this will be the worst cash shortfall we will have ever faced.”

Would you have then gone to your staff and customers and said: “Don't worry, it will be fine, it's not a big problem, it will disappear, like magic”? Would you have done a few things to hopefully fix the problem, tinkering around the edges, telling those loyal to you not to worry, and then tell your accountant that you know more about accounting than she does and to stop being so pessimistic?

No, of course not.

Like any competent leader, you would have rallied the troops, come up with a game plan, battened down the hatches, and looked for every possible solution you or your team could have thought of.

But no, instead, you the CEO and your executives (let's call them the “House Democrats”) tried a few programs, but, unable to agree on the next course of action, stalled and continued to do nothing.

And now, here we are, months later, and the cash shortfall everyone predicted is ravaging your business.

So no, the Democrats aren't a lot better. Unable to compromise with their sworn enemy and therefore unable to come up with the third round of relief,

let alone a bill that would specifically help and bolster small business, the Democrats are left hoping that the stench of this economic calamity will waft more onto the president than them, and come November, the electorate will want to get rid of the stench and vote them into power.

Aside from the pure cynicism of that ploy, it is hard to argue that this pandemic has been anything but botched by the unholy triumvirate of an incompetent administration, do-nothing Senate Republicans (who are either unable or unwilling to pass anything but a “skinny” relief bill – gee, thanks) and the lying-in-wait Democrats.

But, that said, it is also true that the team out of power deserves less blame and therefore probably also deserves a chance to try to right the ship.

After all, the Democrats did fix the economic free fall we experienced in 2008, and that is not an insignificant achievement or precedent.

But before we get there, it is simply inexcusable that the two parties cannot agree on some additional compromise relief effort, especially for the millions of small businesses affected, and the millions more out of work, all of whom are drowning in this witch's brew of a virus, economic collapse, and political incompetence.

Companies will release diversity data

Some 34 firms will disclose employee demographic figures

Nearly three dozen major U.S. companies including Amazon, General Motors, Target and Wells Fargo have agreed to share the diversity reports they file each year with the federal government.

The disclosures from 34 Standard & Poor's 100 companies are the result of a campaign by New York City Comptroller Scott Stringer following the killing of George Floyd, a Black man who died under the knee of a white policeman in Minneapolis.

“By publicly disclosing the demographics of employees by race, gender, and ethnicity – including leadership roles and senior management – these companies will provide crucial information for shareholders to better understand diversity and workforce practices – and identify areas for growth,” Stringer said in a statement.

Some companies including BlackRock, Chevron, Target and Verizon have begun releasing the reports.

News organizations including USA TODAY have fought for the disclosure of this demographic information. Only in recent years have some of the na-

tion's top companies opened up about the persistent lack of diversity in their ranks, particularly at the highest levels.

The EEO-1 report, which provides a breakdown by race and gender in 10 job categories, is the “gold standard” for diversity disclosure, Stringer said.

A USA TODAY analysis showed that, while corporations and boardrooms have added African Americans over the decades, the executive suite has not, even at companies that have diverse boards.

USA TODAY reviewed the most recent proxy statements for the 50 largest companies in the Standard & Poor's 100 as of July 15.

Nearly all – 48 – issued statements in support of the Black community after Floyd's death May 25.

Yet corporate America's top ranks look nothing like the country they serve. Of the 279 top executives listed in the proxy statements, only five, or 1.8%, were Black, including two who recently retired.

Many of these megacompanies are still led by all-white executives in the top five slots listed on proxy statements. In some cases, companies also list other top-paid officers who recently left. In all 279 listed, executives appear on the 50 proxy statements examined by USA TODAY.

Any company with 100 or more employees as well as some federal contractors are required to submit the report to the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission.

Raw data offers “standardized, quantitative, relevant and comparable employment data across companies and industries,” Stringer said.

Target's report, for example, shows that 40 of its 777 executive or senior-level employees were Black or 5.1% and 50 were Hispanic or Latino or 6.4%. At Chevron, 32 out of 971 executive or senior-level employees were Black or 3.3% and 60 were Hispanic or Latino or about 6.2%.

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MLB PLAYOFFS

Athletics extend series; rookie sparks Braves

Chad Pinder tied the score with a three-run homer in the seventh inning, Sean Murphy hit a go-ahead sacrifice fly in the eighth and the Oakland Athletics rallied past the Houston Astros 9-7 on Wednesday to avoid elimination in their American League Division Series.

Houston leads the best-of-five series 2-1 and can advance to its fourth straight AL Championship Series with a victory on Thursday in Los Angeles.

The Astros wasted leads of 2-1 and 7-4, and the Athletics bounced back after giving up advantages of 1-0 and 4-2. Houston's bullpen had stifled Oakland in the first two games with seven scoreless innings of one-hit relief, but Pinder ended that dominance.

Houston led 7-4 when Marcus Semien and Tommy La Stella had back-to-back singles off Josh James starting the seventh. Pinder hit a first-pitch slider to the opposite field for Oakland's fifth homer, a drive chased by right fielder Kyle Tucker until he ran out of room.

La Stella, Mark Canha, Matt Olson and Semien also homered for the A's, whose entire infield went deep. Teams outhomering opponents are 18-0 in the postseason.

The teams have combined for 18 homers – including seven in Game 3 – in the neutral-site series at Dodger Stadium featuring all day games.

Braves 2, Marlins 0: Rookie Ian Anderson pitched like an October veteran. Old pro Nick Markakis threw the best strike of the game. Just like that, Atlanta is on the verge of something they haven't done since the days of Chipper, the Big Three and Bobby Cox.

Anderson blanked Miami into the sixth inning, Markakis made a nifty play in right field to help preserve the lead late, and the Braves threw another playoff shutout in a 2-0 victory Wednesday for a 2-0 lead in the National League Division Series in Houston.

The Braves have pitched three shutouts in four games during this year's playoffs. They're just the third team in MLB history to toss three shutouts in the first four games of a postseason, joining the 1966 Baltimore Orioles and the 1905 New York Giants.

Travis d'Arnaud and Dansby Swanson each homered for the second day in a row, putting the Braves one win away from a sweep. Game 3 is Thursday.

"It's hard to bunch hits together, pitching is too good," Braves manager Brian Snitker said. "Power, I think is something that plays in the postseason and was witnessed today."

Atlanta hasn't reached the NL Championship Series since 2001 when Chipper Jones, Greg Maddux, Tom Glavine and John Smoltz played under Cox.

The Braves have lost in the division series eight times since then, including in the last two seasons – a fact star slugger Freddie Freeman said put a chip on their shoulders entering this round.

Anderson scattered three hits and struck out eight over 5 2/3 innings. The right-hander who made his MLB debut in late August added to his impressive outing last week in the wild-card series when he fanned nine in six scoreless frames against Cincinnati.
