It's Mariah and Nicki and the Great 'American' Feud

A 'passionate' new 'Idol' panel fuels rumor mill

PASADENA, CALIF. The feud. If you've paid any attention at all to the news coming out of American Idol, you've heard about "the feud" between new judges Mariah Carey and Nicki Minaj, even up to threats of violence. So is the conflict real, or is it just a press stunt?

"It's authentic," Fox alternative-programming president Mike Darnell insisted to TV writers Tuesday. "There's passion in this group. ... It's not just the girls, it's everybody."

"I feel like this is a very passionate panel," Carey chimed in. "I think there are a lot of strong personalities. Starting this process, I thought there was a possibility that there could be a lot of diverse opinions. ... The fighting is what it is. This is American Idol, it's bigger than all that. It's bigger than some stupid, trumped-up thing."

"It's a distraction from the show," she said. "It's a distraction from the contestants."

As for what actually happened, and

how they got past it, Minaj just said, "Have'n you ever had an argument with anyone you work with?"

"It was sort of one-sided," Carey added. "No, it wasn't," Minaj countered.

So, to put the reports to rest, could the two women say something nice about each other?

"I say nice things about Mariah all the time," Minaj said. "She's one of

my favorite artists of all time. She's really shaped a generation of singers. ... All these singers that come in, they aspire to be Mariah Carey."

For Carey's less-effusive part, she noted that she did a song with Minaj "very early on in her career. ... It's called *Out My Face*, ironically," she said. "I did know and I did feel that she was going to go very far. I'm grateful for anything nice she or

anyone has to say about me. I'm grateful to be here."

As for what to expect from them as judges when *Idol* returns Jan. 16 (8 ET/PT), Minaj said she's there to judge, not just sit there and express support and sympathy.

"We're really paid to do a job. I don't want to be here if I'm not going to do it," she said. "I don't feel the need to send a person through just because of a great story."

KEVIN BACON HUNTS A KILLER

Fox's *The Following* is midseason's most-anticipated new series, but it might make viewers a little queasy.

Kevin Bacon plays a damaged ex-FBI agent who caught a serial killer (James Purefoy) 10 years before. Now he's recruited to find him again, after the killer has developed a cult of "followers" who kill for him. But the duo's shared history complicates the chase: Bacon's Ryan Hardy had an affair with the ex-wife of Purefoy's Joe Carroll, and still pines for her. And the twisted relationships among the followers add a soapy layer to the mayhem.

It's a project that's been percolating in my head for many, many years," says creator Kevin Williamson, who wrote the *Scream* movies

and created *Dawson's Creek* and *The Vampire Diaries*.

Bacon, in his first prime-time series, premiering Jan. 21 (9 ET/PT), says Williamson in many ways is "kind of a softie. He's really interested in the love story of the show, and the personal struggles."

Hardy "carries the weight of every victim on him, and he goes blind with saving people," Williamson says. "He's a heroic, amazing do-gooder, and I try to pair him up with the most brilliant, crazed, evil killer I could find."

That hasn't eased concerns about the show's violence, particularly after the school shooting in Newtown, Conn. Williamson says, "We're all traumatized by it," adding that he rejected a plan to stage a mass shooting in a late-season episode. "There's some moments that are squeamish; it's not for the faint of heart," he says.

"The fun of the show is watching week-to-week what (Carroll) is up to and how is Ryan Hardy getting ahead of it? We don't realize how insidious and how wide the circle is."


