# Ani is the 'Luckiest Girl Alive' — or is she?

*Luckiest Girl Alive* is a beach read with some serious bite. From its opening sentence, this novel and its protagonist, Ani FaNelli, are not what they appear to be.

Magazine writer Ani is not just any girl. She's looking to shake her small-town roots and traumatic past. Ani is the reinvention of TifAni FaNelli and the soon-to-be Mrs. Ani Harrison, wife to Luke, the blue-blooded embodiment of middle-class TifAni's dreams. In addition to planning her wedding, Ani is busy working at the popular *The Women's Magazine* and relentless in her pursuit of reaching physical perfection. It appears Ani has little time for anything else, except perhaps being featured in a documentary film. Yes, Ani's perfect, idealized life seems just within her grasp.

But not so fast. Some of Ani's secrets may come dangerously close to dismantling her finely constructed and well-polished veneer.

Thanks to the first-person narration, we know that the inner Ani is far different from the one she presents to world. But that is only the first of myriad contradictions and plot twists.

Author Jessica Knoll is deft at manipulating perception, both the reader's and the protagonist's. Every time we think we have a handle on where Ani and her story are going, we're surprised by a

well-executed plot twist. *Luckiest Girl Alive* has been compared favorably to other recent *Girl* best sellers, Gillian Flynn's *Gone Girl* and Paula Hawkins' *The Girl on the Train*. And the comparisons are well-deserved. Knoll's *Girl* shares

those thrillers' "didn't-see-that-coming" plot lines.

And *Girl Alive* is just as dark. Recent newsworthy topics create a backdrop that can, at times, make the reader uncomfortable. Yet the visceral tension Knoll

creates actually complements the reading experience. You *feel* this book.

Reese Witherspoon has called *Luckiest Girl Alive* "required summer reading for adults." You'll agree.

# It's a matter of trust for Batman, Superman

The superheroes will figure out if they're superfriends, too

Sometimes it's better to see Batman and Superman not as BFFs but as frenemies.

That's what's happening on the big screen in next year's *Batman v Superman: Dawn of Justice*. And a contentious relationship between the two superfriends was an early hallmark of writer Greg Pak's *Batman/Superman* comic book, though they became pals as the DC Comics series progressed and they grew from rookie heroes to world-saving veterans.

The dynamic has changed

again: Clark Kent is less than all-powerful, and it's not Bruce Wayne with the cape and cowl anymore. Instead, a more vulnerable Man of Steel and Jim Gordon, a new Dark Knight in high-tech armor, are having to figure out if they, too, can depend on each other.

"The theme for this book from the beginning has really been about trust and friendship and about the way rivals and friends push us to become who we are supposed to become," says Pak, part of the *Batman/Superman* creative team with artists Ardiian Syaf and Vicente Cifuentes.

Now, this new scenario has two characters "who you're not quite sure they're going to be able to accomplish everything they have to accomplish," the writer says. "That creates real drama. And it tests their spirit in all the right

kinds of ways."

In *Batman/Superman* No. 23, out Wednesday, Clark goes searching under Gotham City for the beast lord Ukur to find out what plans the antagonist has with his subterranean army, finding some surprising guests down there along the way.

At the same time, Superman's also questioning himself. Depowered to a certain degree and with his secret identity out in the open, Clark is definitely having a crisis of confidence.

"He'd desperately love to have Bruce to lean on, but Bruce is gone and Clark under very different circumstances has to deal with a whole new Batman who has no idea who this new Superman is," says Pak, who also writes about the Man of Steel in *Action Comics*.

"As far as Gordon knows, this

guy in a Superman T-shirt just showed up and started beating people up in Gotham City: 'Who is this guy?!'"

One of the things Pak likes about writing the *Bat-Gordon* series is that the former Gotham cop would love to automatically believe this Superman is the same guy all about truth, justice and the American way — Gordon's "got the golden-est of golden hearts," the writer says — but Gotham's new crusader just can't afford to, with the stakes so high.

There is a massive reveal at the end of issue 23 where a key DC character meets the new-look Superman for the first time — Pak teases that "the results may not be very pretty."

That plays out in *Batman/Superman* No. 24, where Superman and Batman will figure out if they're to be friends or enemies.



Luminant Mining Company LLC ("Luminant"), 1601 Bryan Street, Dallas, Texas 75201 has submitted an application entitled Leesburg Mine, Permit No. 51 Renewal/Revision, Supplemental Document No. 2 (SD2) ("Application"), to the Railroad Commission of Texas Surface Mining and Reclamation Division ("Commission") to renew existing Permit No. 51 for an additional five year term. No additional mining is proposed for the renewal term. The existing permit area is located in Camp County, Texas. Permit No. 51 was issued on June 10, 2008 and contains approximately 4,516 acres. The original application for renewal/revision of Permit No. 51 was submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas on March 19, 2012, consisting of 10-volumes including a request to expand the existing permit boundary by approximately 52-acres to support the proposed mining operations. Luminant subsequently filed Supplemental Document No. 1 on June 2, 2014 in response to the application de-

ficiencies noted by the Railroad Commission's technical review Staff. Supplemental Document No. 2 to the application was filed with the Commission on May 15, 2015 and will replace the original application and Supplemental Document No. 1.

During an informal conference held in Austin, Texas on September 16, 2014, Luminant informed the Railroad Commission of Texas that its long-range fuel plan analysis did not include lignite fuel from the Leesburg Mine during the proposed permit renewal term. Luminant also stated its desire to remove all proposed mining operations and preserve the original Permit No. 51 boundary by removing the proposed expansion area. Therefore, Supplemental Document No. 2 will replace the original application for renewal and Supplemental Document No. 1. Certain administrative sections of the permit will be updated and provided in the SD2 document.

Ownership of all affected lands within and adjacent to the 4,516-acre permit area is described in Section 116 of the Application. Permit Sections .125 (Life of Mine), .139 (Mine Plan Operations), .148 (Surface Water Control) contain maps that depict the complete removal of mining operations. If and when Luminant ever proposes mining operations in the future, public notice of an application for revised operations will be

published again for public review.

There are several producing oil or gas wells located within the permit renewal area and other oil/gas information can be found in Section .116, Appendix F.

A copy of the complete Application may be inspected in the main office of the Railroad Commission of Texas at 1701 North Congress, William B. Travis Building, Austin, Texas, the Tyler Regional Office at 2202 Old Henderson Highway, Tyler, Texas or at the office of the Camp County Clerk, located at 126 Church Street, Room 102, Pittsburg, Texas.

**The Application may be supplemented from time to time, with supplemental information placed in separate volumes and filed for public inspection. Interested persons should contact the Hearings Examiner or continue to check the public copies of the Application to determine their current status.**

As shown on the associated location map, the Leesburg Mine is located approximately 4-miles west of the town of Pittsburg, Texas, approximately 4-miles south of Lake Bob Sandlin and approximately 0.5-miles east of Leesburg, Texas. The permit boundary is formed to the north by the Kansas City Railroad, State Highway 11 and FM 3042. The western and south-

ern boundaries are formed by FM 1519, while the eastern boundary is formed by Camp County Road No. 3216 and various property tracts. The permit area is contained within the U.S. Geological Survey 7.5 minute, "Leesburg" and "Monticello" quadrangle maps.

The Application is made pursuant to the Texas Surface Coal Mining and Reclamation Act, TEX. NAT. RES. CODE ANN. Chapter 134 (Vernon Supp. 2015) and the Coal Mining Regulations, Texas Railroad Commission, 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE (Ch.12) (Thomson West 2015). 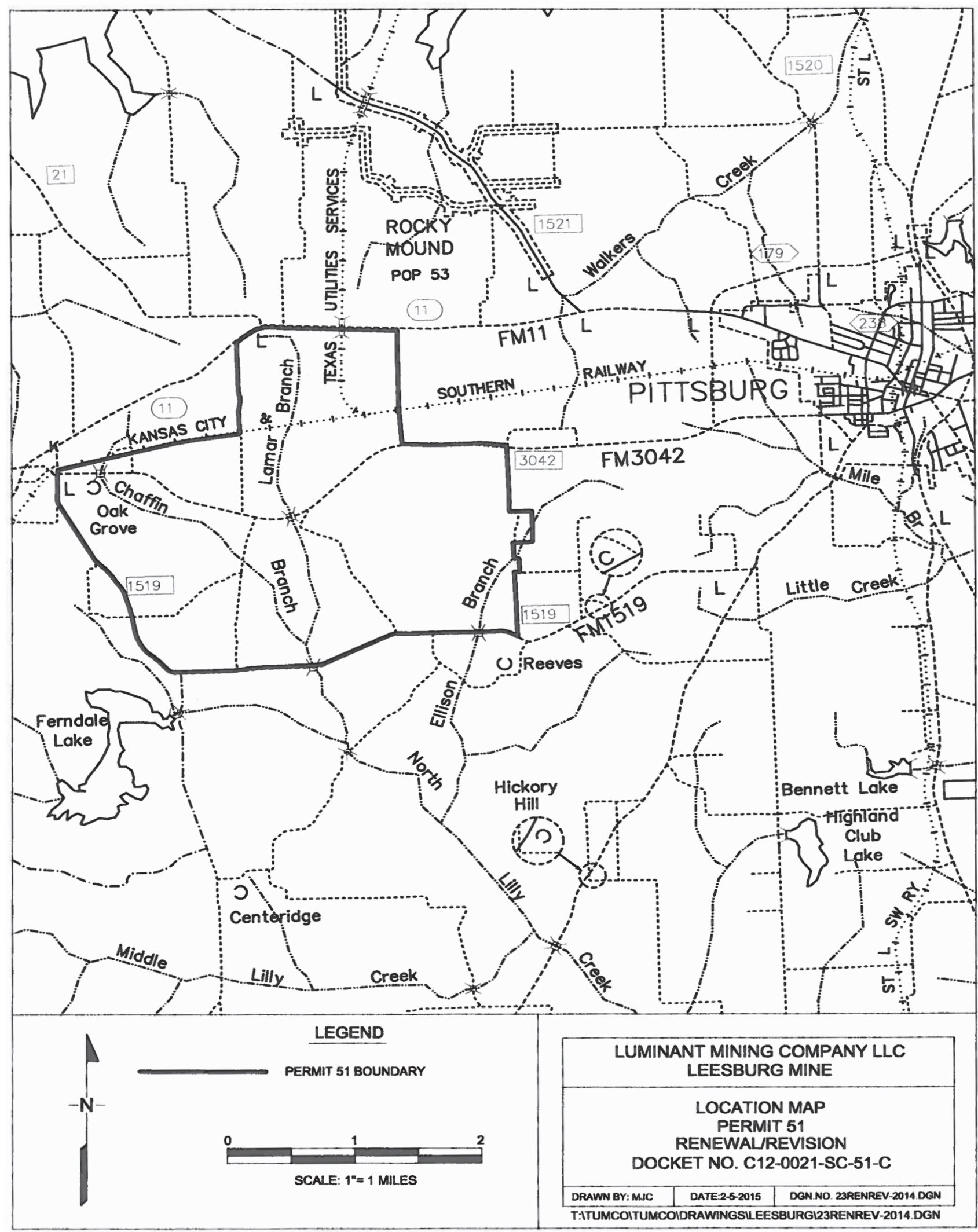

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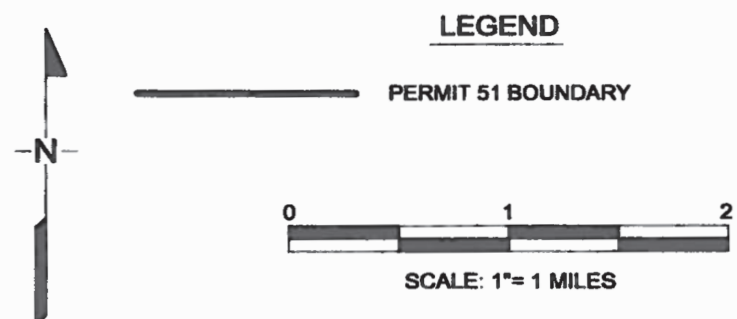
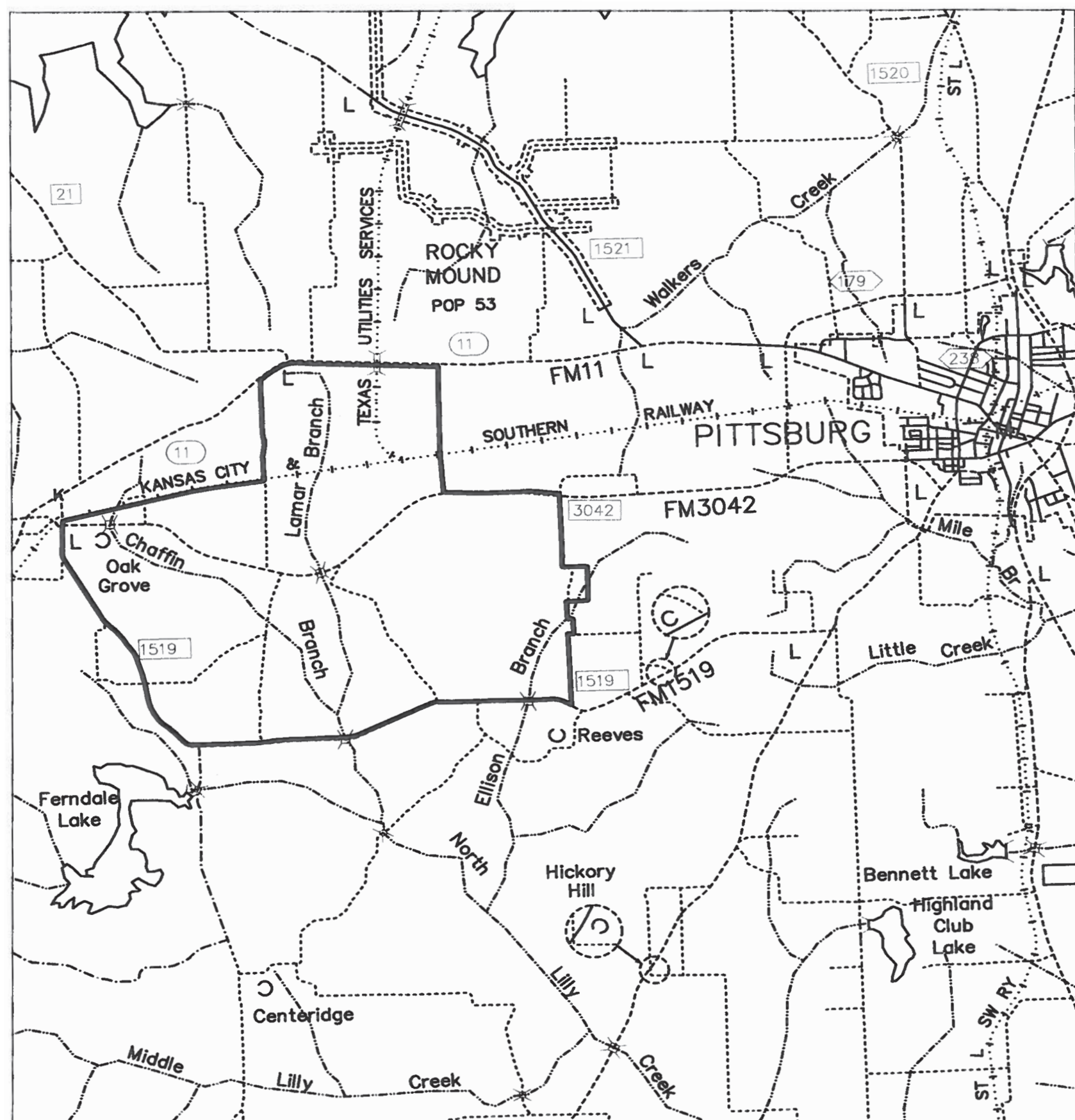
