Gay Talese's 'Voyeur's Motel' is a real turnoff

Early in Gay Talese's new book, The Voyeur's Motel (Grove Press, 240 pp., ★☆☆☆ out of four), the writer and

New Journalism pioneer recounts his first meeting with Gerald Foos, an unabashed peeping Tom. That evening, Talese followed Foos into a janitorial closet and up a ladder leading to the roadside Colorado motel's secret attic. It's where the perverted motelier had installed a soundproof observation crawlspace equipped with customized phony ceiling vents. Together, through one of those vents, they watched as a young couple made love.

Creepy? Hold that room-service call. Read on.

Long before Erin Andrews' stalker gave hotel peepholes a bad name, Foos had gone undetected more than three decades watching the sexual activities of thousands of guests. He often masturbated or had sex with his wife in the attic while ogling his victims. He scribbled graphic yet stiffly clinical notes in his journal, chronicling the sexual behaviors of young lovers, middle-age cou-





ples, lesbians, gays, gigolos, prostitutes, threesomes, cheaters, and on and on. Many of his observations are excerpted in this book.

Now, the entire book, scheduled to be published July 12, is in question after The Washington Post reported that property records show Foos sold the motel in 1980 and reacquired it in 1988. Talese told the paper he would not promote The Voyeur's Motel, first excerpted in The New Yorker, because its "credibility is down the toilet." Foos, however, says everything he told Talese is true

even though he never disclosed the property transaction.

(Publisher Grove Press released a statement standing by the book, and Talese disavowed his disavowal: "Gerald Foos, as no one calls into question, was an epic voyeur, and, as I say very clearly in the text, he could also at times be an unreliable teller of his own peculiar story. When I spoke to the Washington Post reporter, I am sure I was surprised and upset about this business of the later ownership of the motel, in the '80s. That occurred after the bulk of the events covered in my book, but I was upset and probably said some things I didn't, and don't, mean. Let me be clear: I am not disavowing the book and neither is my publisher. If, down the line, there are details to correct in later editions, we'll do that.")

In 1980, during the pre-publication hoopla for Talese's acclaimed, sexually explosive Thy Neighbor's Wife, Foos sent the author an anonymous letter describing his voyeur habits. claiming he was chronicling America's changing sexual landscape from the '60s Sexual Revolution and on. He thought Talese might use some of it in a future book. Soon after, Talese visited the Manor House Motel in Aurora where he and Foos made several trips to the attic.

But Talese refused to publish non-fiction without naming names, and Foos feared the law and bankruptcy from civil suits, so it took 35 more years for the two of them to go public. Foos, 80, had retired and figured the statutes of limitations on his crimes had expired. Plus, he wanted recognition for what he believes is his earthshaking study of human sexuality.

Meanwhile, Foos claims he saw more than he ever envisioned:

robberies, violence, drug deals, incest, bestiality, sexual exploitation and rape. He says he even witnessed a murder — but cooperating fully with the cops would have jeopardized his secret life.

Ironically, what Foos hated most was when guests were dishonest with one another. To his credit, Talese confides that he was "deeply unsettled by the way (Foos) had violated his customers' trust and invaded their privacy." Still, Talese, now 84, could not stop looking ... or writing.

In the end, this book is no contribution to "social history," as Foos and Talese suggest. It is, at best, a lewd and licentious footnote to Talese's They Neighbor's Wife. Foos is nothing more than an arrogant, delusional jerk who believes his years of illegal activity have value and mistakes his attic as moral high ground.

The sad upshot: Foos and Talese are lurking kindred spirits. And Talese's journalistic rationale for writing this book sounds pathetically like saying you buy Playboy for the articles.

But wait, doesn't sex sell, even when it's sleaze? Steven Spielberg bought the rights to the book for a film adaptation to be directed by Sam Mendes, whose breakthrough film was ... American Beauty.

Logo introducing a TV first: A gay dating competition

Move over. The Bachelor: TV's first gay dating show is due this fall on Logo.

Finding Prince Charming, hosted by Lance Bass, will feature a cast of gay men in a contest that includes 13 suitors housed together, vying for the affection of what the cable network describes as one of the nation's most eligible gay men.

The premise is familiar: Contestants are hoping for a roman-

love. The suitors will be eliminated one by one until the heartthrob chooses the "winner" for a potentially exclusive relationship. His identity has not been revealed, nor has Logo set a premiere date for the series.

But Finding Prince Charming comes amid growing awareness of the diversity deficiencies of ABC's The Bachelor and The Bachelorette, and it follows a new batch of knockoff shows that respond to those concerns.

VH1's Dating Naked (Wednesdays, 9 ET/PT) has its first black main dater in the current third season, and WEtv's Match tic connection and, maybe, true Made in Heaven (Thursdays,

10 ET/PT) focuses on black contestants vying for the attention of former NFL player Stevie Baggs and features actress Sherri Shepherd as a "Sherri godmother."

The new season of Lifetime's UnREAL (Mondays, 10 ET/PT), a scripted drama set behind the scenes at the fictional Everlasting, includes a black suitor as part of its major story line.

Still, Finding Prince Charming appears to be a good fit for Viacom-owned Logo, best known for another competition series, RuPaul's Drag Race.

"Logo has a long history of showcasing LGBTQ-focused stories with memorable characters that transcend pop culture," Pamela Post, chief of original programming for Logo, said in a statement.

"Finding Prince Charming will take viewers on a whirlwind journey through modern love and relationships in a way that only Logo can do."

Brian Graden, a former programming chief at Logo and MTV, is producing the series.


