BASEBALL

A's might look to add, not subtract

Oakland appears to have staved off annual July purge

OAKLAND - The running joke around the Athletics at this time of year is that any veteran having a good season should keep his bags packed.

On the way to finishing last in the American League West each of the last three years, the A's entered July with 35 wins every time, a clear signal to their already trigger-happy management to start moving assets.

That's how the likes of Ben Zobrist, Rich Hill, Josh Reddick, Sonny Gray, Sean Doolittle, Ryan Madson, Yonder Alonso and Scott Kazmir wound up finishing their seasons elsewhere.


"We joke about that," said infielder Jed Lowrie, who's making a case for his first All-Star Game invite. "We're not naive to the track record of the organiza-

So it's hard to bet on Oakland keeping valuable players such as Lowrie and closer Blake Treinen past the July 31 trade deadline. But given their June surge and 48-39 record, the A's could be open for business again this month this time as buyers.

General manager David Forst said he's telling opposing clubs that Oakland is looking to upgrade, though that could be subject to change depending on what transpires in the next few weeks. Even after winning 14 of their past 16 games, the A's trail the Mariners by seven games for the second AL wild card.

Still, for a team that raised few outside expectations coming into the season and has six starting pitchers on the disabled list, arriving at this point with a fighting chance merits acknowledgment and perhaps extra support.

"This team has played well, and if there's a chance to make them better

right now, we have to consider that," Forst said. "We know how precious any playoff opportunity is. You don't take that for granted just because maybe coming into the year you weren't expected to be there. We will certainly spend the month of July talking with other teams and looking to see what upgrades are possible for this team but also keeping an eye on the future as we always do."

The A's did not join the game's widespread tanking trend in the offseason but didn't make major acquisitions either, opting to continue building around a young nucleus that features third

baseman Matt Chapman, first baseman Matt Olson and left-hander Sean Manaea.

All three have been factors in Oakland's improvement — Manaea's eight wins lead the pitching staff, and the Matts have combined to hit 28 home runs — but a good chunk of the contributions also have come from more established players.

DH Khris Davis has hit 20 home runs and driven in 57 runs, two fewer than Lowrie's team-leading 59. Both rank among the league's top 10 in RBI. Lowrie, besides providing a stabilizing presence as an 11-year veteran, has the highest OPS of any Athletic at .855.

And Treinen, 30, is having the best season of his career, not only converting 22 of 24 save chances but boasting the AL's best ERA among relievers at 0.84. He heads a solid late-inning corps that has allowed the A's to go 34-0 when leading after seven innings, the majors' only unbeaten team in those situations.

No wonder, then, A's players are ready to move past the old joke and set their sights on contending.

"Although I can see the comedy in it," outfielder Mark Canha said, "I like to think that right now we're thinking more along the lines of, 'Who are we going to get?'

The A's could possibly upgrade without making any moves, considering starting pitchers Trevor Cahill, Daniel Mengden and Brett Anderson figure to be back in the next couple of weeks. That would leave management enough time to assess whether the chances of challenging for a playoff spot are real or chimerical.

Lowrie, now in his second tour of duty in Oakland, played on the 2013 and 2014 teams that reached the postseason and says this is the most fun he's ever had in baseball, partly because this mix of veterans and youngsters has bonded

The never-say-die A's have scored the winning run in the eighth inning or later in eight of their last 17 victories, and they're among the majors' most prolific clubs scoring from the seventh

So while aware of the possibility he might get traded, Lowrie is not discounting an extended run.

"I've been here when we're acquiring people at the deadline," said Lowrie, who will be a free agent after the season. "In my experience, the front office is cognizant of that. I don't think they're going to waste opportunities. I think they'll do what's best if we're in a position to compete at the deadline and we're in it. In the past they've given the club a chance. I don't think it's out of the question."

Like Black Friday and Cyber Monday, Amazon's annual Prime Day features tons of products screaming "deal!" But sometimes it's tough to separate the big discounts from the disappointments. Here's how to make sense of the sale that starts Monday.

What to buy ... and what not to

Lots of gadgets and tech accessories will be discounted for the sale, but products from Apple and Google from iPhones and MacBooks to Pixel phones and Google Home - probably won't see much love.

The three tech companies don't always play nice with each other, so it's typical for Apple and Google not to do anything special those days. What discounts you do see on iPads or Chromebooks mainly come from third-party sellers. Those deals are rarely as good as sale prices from retailers like Best Buy or Walmart, so it's best to just avoid them. Amazon's own gadgets, by contrast, are a great buy on Prime Day because the company is pulling out all the stops. Things like Fire tablets, Kindle readers and Echo speakers will be at rock-bottom prices.

Move fast on lightning deals

The Lighting Deals on Prime Day are notoriously frustrating to score. If you see an item you want for a price that seems too good to be true, nab it quick or you'll be cursing your slow fingers later.

Ask Alexa

Amazon's voice-controlled assistant Alexa usually has a secret tip or two as well. If you already own an Amazon Echo, try asking Alexa for Prime Day deals early; Alexa should reply with a cryptic message or poem to reveal deals several days early.

No Prime membership? No prob

If you've never subscribed before, you can get a free one-month Amazon Prime trial. Sign up now and you'll be able to shop Prime Day during the trial

shave U.S. economic growth by half a percentage point over the next year if they remained in place, said Mark Zandi, chief economist of Moody's Analytics. China, he said, would sustain a similar pullback in growth.

Greg Daco, head of U.S. economics for Oxford Economics, reckoned China would suffer even more because trade represents nearly 20 percent of its economy while it makes up about 14 percent of the U.S. economy.

Yet the U.S., China and Europe all would topple into recession if Trump imposes all the tariffs he has threatened on top of those already levied - a total \$560 billion in duties – especially since the moves would decimate stocks and consumer and business confidence, Daco said.

Here's a breakdown of the risks and rewards of the trade battle:


Jobs

Risks: American companies cut jobs as they move production to foreign markets to avoid Chinese tariffs on U.S. goods.

All of the tariffs already imposed or threatened in the U.S.-China dispute would mean 700,000 fewer U.S. jobs, Zandi estimated.

Chinese companies could use the same strategy, closing factories in that country, laying off workers and moving production into the U.S. to avoid tariffs and be closer to American customers. About 700,000 to 1 million jobs could be lost in Chinese cities, said Daco of Oxford Economics.

Rewards: If Chinese tariffs on American goods are lowered as a result of successful negotiations, the long-

term effect could be positive for U.S. workers. That's because lower costs should translate into higher profits and higher sales.

Investments

Risks: China retaliates by dumping its massive holdings of U.S. government bonds, a move that would likely boost borrowing costs in the U.S. and cause tumult in financial markets.

China is the No. 1 foreign investor in U.S. Treasuries, with holdings of \$1.18 trillion at the end of April, according to the Department of the Treasury and Federal Reserve.

The problem, however, is that the Chinese will also suffer financial pain, said Peter Hooper, chief U.S. economist at Deutsche Bank in New York.

Other risks: U.S. companies that do business in China face increased restrictions, damaging their sales and profitability.

Rewards: China agrees to lower barriers to entry, enabling freer access for U.S. companies. This could include lifting requirements to share profits and intellectual property with Chinese companies.

Geopolitics

Risks: China retaliates by refusing to help the U.S. negotiate a drawdown of nuclear weapons in North Korea. China could also bolster its economic ties to other Asian countries.

China has a political edge in this respect because President Xi Jinping can impose sweeping unilateral action without facing the political backlash that might occur in the U.S.

"Xi is in for life; Donald Trump has a midterm election to worry about," David Rosenberg, chief economist and strategist at Toronto-based Gluskin Sheff, wrote in a report. "China plays the long game in any event and at all times."

Rewards: Other countries, fearing economic losses in their own trade war with the U.S., agree to concessions under the premise that if the U.S. is willing to risk its lucrative relationship with China, surely it will do the same with them.

PR brand suicide

Schnatter made a serious blunder last November when he blamed slowing sales on the NFL's handling of black players kneeling during the national anthem, noted Eric Schiffer, chairman of Reputation Management Consultants, a firm that guides Fortune 500 companies and senior leaders through the kinds of crises of which Papa John's is now in the midst.

"This is public relations brand suicide, and it's very serious to spew hate from the founder of the company. ... He has proven to be a dumb mouthpiece," Schiffer said.

Crisis management

Papa John's top leaders "are in the bunker now," working on emergency strategies to repair the company's relationship with consumers, particularly those in minority communities, Schiffer

The company has some work to do to win back African-American customers who are bound to feel insulted by Schnatter's remarks. It also faces the challenge of reassuring employees that they work in an accepting environment where diversity is celebrated, he said.

The company needs to own the problem and be transparent about how it intends to make things right, Schiffer said, which may include reaching out to leaders in the African-American community to forge new relationships. Scholarship funding and other philanthropic support is one way to do that, but it's most important to be sincere. It's a case of "what you do versus what you say."

Starbucks recently found itself in hot water over its managers' handling of black customers in one of its Philadelphia cafes. That was a problem with local management, in contrast with Schnatter as Papa John's highly visible

spokesman and brand ambassador. That has a far more extensive effect.

Ties to a toxic boss

Craig Buffkin, managing partner at Buffkin/Baker, an executive recruiting agency, said Papa John's is unique in maintaining such a long connection to the company's roots. "You don't have too many chairmen and founders that continue as the face of the company for as long as he has," Buffkin said.


Companies often pivot away from their founders and bring in fresh leaders to remain nimble and aggressive, he said. "The velocity of change right now is incredible," Buffkin said. "It's a challenging process" for anybody walking into the executive offices."

But while Schnatter is stepping down as chairman, he retains huge influence through his large stake in its stock. And although the company may be going through difficulty now, it likely will survive the incident because "the public has a short memory," Schiffer said.


