'Disaster' maps road to failure in Vietnam



The Vietnam War continues to haunt America's conscience, as well as historians, who keep searching for the truth of how we stumbled into Southeast Asia and stayed year after bloody year.

Our latest literary attempt at understanding the war comes from Brian VanDeMark, a history professor at the United States Naval Academy who has written "Road to Disaster: A New History of America's Descent Into Vietnam" (Custom House, 542 pp., $\star\star\star\star$), an absolutely first-rate analysis of U.S. involvement in that war-torn country.

VanDeMark brings invaluable perspective to this evaluation. He co-wrote

"In Retrospect: The Tragedy and Lessons of Vietnam," a remarkable 1995 book by former Defense Secretary Robert McNamara that gave a compelling account of the events that drove the war.

As a researcher, VanDeMark worked closely with both McNamara, perhaps the American official most closely associated with the war, and with Clark Clifford, who replaced McNamara as defense secretary and championed a policy of de-escalation.

These relationships and the author's previous work provide detailed historical background. We learn about the inability of civilian leaders and military brass to trust one another, diplomatic assertions that were hideously wrong, the military's arrogant mistakes and the utter failure of Americans to understand the Vietnamese people they were fighting for, and against.

This book, however, goes further by incorporating research from psychologists and behavioral scientists to answer: How did they get it so wrong?

The result is an engrossing narrative of the inept handling of the war, and how bad decisions can be made by intelligent, well-meaning officials responsible for millions of lives. Simply put, Americans blew it by making unsound choices and refusing to reconsider con-

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clusions once they were made.

Consider the U.S. bombing of North Vietnam. American generals were convinced the North could be bombed into submission, but they were basing their belief on past success against an industrialized enemy in World War II. Vietnam, however, was an agricultural nation with relatively little industry, so the bombs had little effect, other than to stir up civilian resentment against America and strengthen the North's resolve.

And back home, President Lyndon Johnson faced relentless political pressure to succeed in Vietnam and growing public opposition to the war. The administration fell victim to the sunk cost fallacy - "the more invested people and organizations are in a failing course of action, the more unwilling they are to give up and change their course."

America invested heavily and tragically in Vietnam: wealth, pride and blood. "Road to Disaster" is a compelling account of how that expenditure was made and will leave readers wondering how new investments, in Afghanistan, Iraq and elsewhere, are being decided now.

Trump orders sanctions to deter meddling Move to protect elections

aimed at Russia, others

WASHINGTON - President Donald Trump signed a sweeping executive order Wednesday authorizing sanctions on any foreign individual or country that tries to interfere in U.S. elections.

"This is intended to be a very broad effort to prevent foreign manipulation of the political process," John Bolton, Trump's national security adviser, told reporters in a briefing Wednesday.

The move comes less than two months before the midterm elections and just weeks after Dan Coats, Trump's director of national intelligence, warned of a "pervasive messaging campaign by Russia to try to weaken and divide the United States" before

Americans go to the polls in November.

The executive order could blunt momentum in Congress for legislation that would impose harsher and more direct penalties on Russia for any future election meddling. Several senators said Wednesday that the White House order was a good first step but fell short of what's needed and could give Trump too much wiggle room.

"While the administration has yet to share the full text, an executive order that inevitably leaves the President broad discretion to decide whether to impose tough sanctions against those who attack our democracy is insufficient," said Sen Mark Warner, D-Va., the top Democrat on the Senate investigation into Russia.

"If we are going to actually deter Russia and others from interfering in our elections in the future, we need to spell out strong, clear consequences, without ambiguity," Warner said.

Coats said the new executive order is a response to Russia's actions in the 2016 election and "to make sure that doesn't happen again. But he said the order will apply not just to Russia but to others possible bad actors, including China, North Korea, and Iran.

"We have seen signs of (election

meddling from) not just Russia, but from China ... from Iran and even North Korea," Coats said. "We're taking noth-

ing for granted." The order sets up a process for the U.S. intelligence community and other law enforcement officials to investigate

possible election meddling. First, it requires the Director of National Intelligence to conduct regular assessments of possible election interference. And after each election, the intelligence community will have 45 days to investigate whether there was an attempt at interference, followed by a Justice Department review.

If there is a consensus that a foreign country or other entity tried to meddle in the election, automatic sanctions would be triggered, Coats said.

Bolton said the sanctions would be imposed not just for direct actions, but also for distribution of propaganda and disinformation.

"However, he violated company policy and it is our commitment to uphold these policies at every level," Rhodes wrote.

Nebraska's highest court dismissed a lawsuit that would have stripped a Medicaid expansion proposal off the November ballot. The ruling cleared the way for voters to decide a measure that has been repeatedly rejected by the Republican-dominated Legislature.

US says Saudi Arabia, UAE protecting civilians in Yemen war

Despite mounting civilian casualties, the Trump administration has determined Saudi Arabia and the United Arab Emirates are doing enough to protect civilians in their military campaign in Yemen. The move announced Wednesday by Secretary of State Mike Pompeo allows the administration to continue to support the Saudi-led coalition in operations against Iranian-backed rebels that have been denounced by human rights groups as possible war crimes.

Authorities say Oregon hiker probably was killed by cougar

Officials say a dead hiker whose body was recovered this week likely was killed by a cougar, the first fatal attack by a wild cougar in Oregon and second in the Pacific Northwest this year. Search teams found the body of Diana Bober, 55, on Monday off a trail in the Mount Hood National Forest in Welches, some 40 miles southeast of Portland.

Agency estimates 18 million new cancer cases globally this year

The World Health Organization's cancer research arm estimated in a report released Wednesday there will be about 18 million new cases of cancer globally this year and more than 9 million deaths. The numbers published by the International Agency for Research on Cancer were slightly higher than those in the last update in 2012, when officials expected 14 million new cancer cases and 8 million deaths.

Migrant debate 'no excuse' for far-right violence, Merkel says

German Chancellor Angela Merkel on Wednesday assured Parliament she takes seriously concerns about crimes committed by migrants and pledged a strong response but condemned recent demonstrations as "hateful."

Merkel said there is "no excuse" for expressions of hate, Nazi sympathies or violence. The comments come after the killing of a German man, which led to the arrests of an Iraqi and a Syrian, and prompted days of protests.

This is to give notice that the City of Pittsburg has determined that the following proposed action under Texas Capital Fund Grant (funding pending), is located in a floodplain and/or wetland, and the City will be identifying and evaluating practicable alternatives to locating the action in the floodplain and/or wetland and the potential impacts on the floodplain and/or wetland from the proposed action, as required by Executive Order 11988 and/or 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management and Protection of Wetlands.

The proposed project will provide water, sewer, and street and drainage improvements in support of Kim's Convenience Stores, LLC. The proposed travel center will be located in the western portion of a 12.49-acre lot. The site will consist of a convenience store with restaurant, parking, etc. The proposed project will be $\,$ located on US 271 across the highway from an auto center near the intersection of US271 and Bradshaw Street. 
