"Cooperative Purchasing for Louisiana Schools"

1) What is TIPS?

TIPS is an acronym for The Interlocal Purchasing System. TIPS is a national purchasing cooperative that offers access to competitively procured purchasing contracts to its membership. TIPS is housed at and managed by the lead agency, Region 8 Education Service Center, located in Pittsburg, Texas.

2) Does TIPS meet the requirement in the new Louisiana Cooperative Purchasing Law LRS 38:2212.1 (N)?

TIPS meets the new requirement as defined in the act: "Qualified Purchasing Cooperative Organization" This means an organization, whether for profit or not for profit, of which two or more public school districts are members and which solicits proposals or bids from vendors of services, materials, equipment, or supplies of the type and nature as may be purchased by a public school district or public school.

3) How much does it cost to be a member of TIPS?

Membership in The Interlocal Purchasing System is free to the schools of Louisiana.

4) How does my organization benefit from using a purchasing cooperative like TIPS?

For LSBA member schools, membership in a purchasing cooperative offers the following benefits:

- Access to competitively procured contracts with quality vendors
- Savings of time and financial resources necessary to fulfill bid requirements
- Assistance with the purchasing process by qualified TIPS staff
- Access to pricing based on "national" high-profile contracts

5) Where are TIPS solicitations advertised?

TIPS solicitations (RFP's/RFQ's) are advertised for 2 consecutive weeks in the Pittsburg Gazette in Pittsburg, Texas as well as on a national scope in the USA Today. Copies of these advertisements are also available to view on the TIPS website.

6) How does my organization become a member of TIPS?

7) How can my business become an Awarded Vendor to sell products or services through TIPS?

The only way a vendor can sell products or services through the TIPS cooperative is to be awarded a contract by TIPS. This can only happen when a vendor responds to a TIPS solicitation (RFP/RFQ) for their specific product or service and meets the scoring requirements to receive an awarded contract from the Region 8 ESC Board of Directors (which serves as the governing board of TIPS).
